<u>civilized</u>	Marked by refinement in taste and manners. A <i>civilized society</i> .
<u>clear</u>	Clear and distinct to the senses easily perceptible. The clear complexion of a healthy young woman.
concentrated	Being the most concentrated solution possible at a given temperature unable to dissolve still more of a substance. <i>A concentrated</i> campaign.
cultivated	Refined and well educated. <i>Cultivated</i> roses.
cultured	Characterized by refined taste and manners and good education. <i>Cultured</i> tumour cells.



discerning	Having or showing good judgement. The brasserie attracts discerning customers.
<u>discriminating</u>	Having or demonstrating ability to recognize or draw fine distinctions. The discriminating eye of the connoisseur.
distilled	Having been shortened so that only the essential meaning or most important aspects remain. <i>Distilled</i> water.
elegant	(of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple. Small churches with elegant white spires.
<u>fastidious</u>	Having complicated nutritional requirements; especially growing only in special artificial cultures. <i>She dressed with fastidious care.</i>
<u>graceful</u>	Suggesting taste, ease, and wealth. She was a tall girl slender and graceful .
perceptive	Of or relating to perception. A perceptive observation.
<u>polished</u>	Accomplished and skilful. Polished rice.
processed	Freed from impurities by processing. Processed ores.
<u>pure</u>	Being chromatically pure not diluted with white or grey or black. <i>Cars can run on pure alcohol.</i>
purified	Having had contaminants removed; cleansed. <i>Purified</i> linseed oil.
rarefied	Of high moral or intellectual value; elevated in nature or style- Oliver Franks. <i>Rarefied</i> scholarly pursuits.
<u>selective</u>	Operating at or responding to a particular frequency. The school was very selective in its admissions.
<u>sensitive</u>	Being susceptible to the attitudes, feelings, or circumstances of others. <i>A</i> sensitive <i>voltmeter</i> .
sifted	(of material) having been passed through a sieve. <i>30g sifted plain flour.</i>
<u>sophisticated</u>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. A sophisticated drama.



<u>strained</u>	Of a mainly liquid substance having been strained to separate out any solid matter. My example may seem a little strained .
<u>stylish</u>	Having elegance or taste or refinement in manners or dress. A stylish cocktail bar.
treated	Subjected to a physical (or chemical) treatment or action or agent. <i>Treated</i> fabrics resist wrinkling.
urbane	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i>Maintained an urbane tone in his letters.</i>

cultivated	Prepared for raising crops by plowing or fertilizing. <i>Cultivated</i> roses.
cultured	(of a pearl) formed round a foreign body inserted into an oyster. A cultured and intelligent man.
<u>dainty</u>	Affectedly dainty or refined. A dainty lace handkerchief.
dandy	Relating to or characteristic of a dandy. <i>His floppy handkerchiefs and antique cufflinks gave him the look of a</i> <i>dandy</i> .
debonair	Confident, stylish, and charming (typically used of a man. <i>Life that is gay brisk and debonair.</i>
decency	Behaviour that conforms to accepted standards of morality or respectability. She had the decency to come and confess.
educated	Having been educated. A Harvard educated lawyer.
elegance	A quality of neatness and ingenious simplicity in the solution of a problem (especially in science or mathematics. <i>The simplicity and elegance of the solution.</i>
elegant	Suggesting taste, ease, and wealth. She was elegant to her fingertips.
enchantingly	In a bewitching manner.
<u>exquisite</u>	A man who is affectedly concerned with his clothes and appearance; a dandy. An exquisite cameo.
foppish	Affecting extreme elegance in dress and manner. A foppish dandy.
genteel	Characterized by exaggerated or affected politeness, refinement, or respectability. A genteel old lady.
gentility	Social superiority as demonstrated by polite and respectable manners, behaviour, or appearances. <i>Her grandmother s pretensions to gentility.</i>
<u>grace</u>	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. A beautiful figure which she used in subtle movements of unparalleled grace.
