### **Definitions of "Regions" as a noun**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “regions” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The approximate amount of something (usually used prepositionally as in `in the region of.*
- *The extended spatial location of something.*
- *A knowledge domain that you are interested in or are communicating about.*
- *A large indefinite location on the surface of the Earth.*
- *A part of an animal that has a special function or is supplied by a given artery or nerve.*



## Synonyms of "Regions" as a noun (4 Words)

- area** A region or part of a town, a country, or the world.  
*The **area** of a triangle.*
- neighborhood** An area within a city or town that has some distinctive features (especially one forming a community).  
*He always blames someone else in the immediate **neighborhood**.*
- part** That which concerns a person with regard to a particular role or situation.  
*She was memorizing a **part**.*
- realm** A field or domain of activity or interest.  
*The **realm** of the occult.*



## Usage Examples of "Regions" as a noun

- *Here we enter the region of opinion.*
- *Penguins inhabit the polar regions.*
- *It was going to take in the region of two or three months to finish the job.*
- *The farming regions of France.*
- *In the abdominal region.*
- *Regions of outer space.*



## Associations of "Regions" (30 Words)

### archipelago

A group of many islands in a large body of water.  
*The Indonesian **archipelago**.*

### area

The extent or measurement of a surface or piece of land.  
*The key **areas** of science.*

### bay

A small recess opening off a larger room.  
*A boat trip round the **bay**.*

### coastal

Of or near a coast.  
***Coastal** waters.*

### district

A region defined for an administrative purpose.  
*The committee **districted** the city into blocks.*

### domain

A distinct subset of the internet with addresses sharing a common suffix or under the control of a particular organization or individual.  
*The country's isolation in the **domain** of sport.*

<b>dune</b>	A mound or ridge of sand or other loose sediment formed by the wind, especially on the sea coast or in a desert. <i>A sand <b>dune</b>.</i>
<b>foreshore</b>	The part of a shore between high- and low-water marks, or between the water and cultivated or developed land.
<b>geographical</b>	Based on or derived from the physical features of an area. <b>Geographical</b> <i>research.</i>
<b>gulf</b>	A deep ravine, chasm, or abyss. <i>The widening <b>gulf</b> between the rich and the poor.</i>
<b>island</b>	A zone or area resembling an island. <i>This <b>island</b> nation.</i>
<b>isle</b>	An island or peninsula, especially a small one. <i>Crusoe s fabled <b>isle</b>.</i>
<b>islet</b>	A portion of tissue structurally distinct from surrounding tissues.
<b>lagoon</b>	An artificial pool for the treatment of effluent or to accommodate an overflow from surface drains during heavy rain.
<b>land</b>	Extensive landed property especially in the country retained by the owner for his own use. <i>The bird <b>landed</b> on the highest branch.</i>
<b>littoral</b>	The littoral zone. <i>Irrigated regions of the Mediterranean <b>littoral</b>.</i>
<b>map</b>	Make a map of show or establish the features of details of. <i>A street <b>map</b>.</i>
<b>maritime</b>	(of climate) moist and temperate owing to the influence of the sea. <b>Maritime</b> <i>law.</i>
<b>municipal</b>	Relating or belonging to or characteristic of a municipality. <b>Municipal</b> <i>offices.</i>
<b>nautical</b>	Relating to or involving ships or shipping or navigation or seamen. <b>Nautical</b> <i>charts.</i>
<b>peninsula</b>	A piece of land almost surrounded by water or projecting out into a body of water.
<b>peninsular</b>	Of or forming or resembling a peninsula. <i>The counties of <b>peninsular</b> Florida.</i>
<b>physiography</b>	The study of physical features of the earth's surface.
<b>province</b>	A territory outside Italy under a Roman governor. <i>It was his <b>province</b> to take care of himself.</i>
<b>seashore</b>	An area of sandy, stony, or rocky land bordering and level with the sea.

<b>southern</b>	Situated in or oriented toward the south. <i><b>Southern</b> cooking.</i>
<b>subdivide</b>	Form into subdivisions. <i>The heading was <b>subdivided</b> into eight separate sections.</i>
<b>underpopulated</b>	Having a lower population density than normal or desirable. <i>The rocky and <b>underpopulated</b> west coast.</i>
<b>zone</b>	Divide into or assign to zones. <i>A pedestrian <b>zone</b>.</i>
<b>zoning</b>	Dividing an area into zones or sections reserved for different purposes such as residence and business and manufacturing etc. <i>Those opposed to <b>zoning</b> argued that the party's presidential standard bearer could come from any part of the country.</i>
