**Register in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **am registering**              We **are registering**  
You **are registering**          You **are registering**  
He/She/It **is registering**      They **are registering**

**Register in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have registered**              We **have registered**  
You **have registered**          You **have registered**  
He/She/It **has registered**      They **have registered**

**Register in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been registering**          We **have been registering**  
You **have been registering**      You **have been registering**  
He/She/It **has been registering**      They **have been registering**

He/She/It **registered**          They **registered**

**Register in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I was registering                      We were registering  
You were registering                You were registering  
He/She/It was registering        They were registering

I will registerate                      We will registerate  
You will registerate                You will registerate  
He/She/It will registerate        They will registerate
