## **Regle in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

#### **Regle in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am regling</b>	We <b>are regling</b>
You <b>are regling</b>	You <b>are regling</b>
He/She/It is regling	They are regling

#### **Regle in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have regled	We have regled
You have regled	You have regled
He/She/It has regled	They have regled

## **Regle in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been regling	We have been regling
You <b>have been regling</b>	You have been regling
He/She/It has been regling	They have been regling

#### **Regle in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I regled	We <b>regled</b>
You <b>regled</b>	You <b>regled</b>
He/She/It <b>regled</b>	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{regled}}$

#### **Regle in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was regling	We were regling
You <b>were regling</b>	You <b>were regling</b>
He/She/It was regling	They were regling

## **Regle in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had regled	We had regled
You <b>had regled</b>	You had regled
He/She/It had regled	They had regled

## **Regle in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been regling	We had been regling
You <b>had been regling</b>	You had been regling
He/She/It had been regling	They had been regling

## **Regle in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will regle	We <b>will regle</b>
You <b>will regle</b>	You <b>will regle</b>
He/She/It will regle	They will regle

## **Regle in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be regling	We <b>will be regling</b>
You <b>will be regling</b>	You will be regling
He/She/It will be regling	They will be regling

I will have been regling	We <b>will have been regling</b>
