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## Associations of "Regularly" (30 Words)

<b>almanac</b>	A handbook, typically published annually, containing information of general interest or on a sport or pastime.
<b><a href="#">annual</a></b>	An annual plant. <i><b>Annual</b> or yearly income.</i>
<b>annually</b>	Once a year; every year. <i>Sales are increasing by about 17 <b>annually</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">biannual</a></b>	Occurring or payable twice each year. <i>The <b>biannual</b> meeting of the planning committee.</i>
<b>biennial</b>	A plant having a life cycle that normally takes two seasons from germination to death to complete flowering biennials usually bloom and fruit in the second season. <i>They met at <b>biennial</b> conventions.</i>
<b>bimonthly</b>	Done, produced, or occurring twice a month or every two months. <i>The magazine appears <b>bimonthly</b>.</i>
<b>biweekly</b>	Occurring twice a week. <i>A <b>biweekly</b> bulletin.</i>
<b><a href="#">calendar</a></b>	Enter something in a calendar or timetable. <i>I have you on my <b>calendar</b> for next Monday.</i>
<b>consistently</b>	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. <i>The vehicle <b>consistently</b> outperforms some of the best competitors.</i>
<b>customarily</b>	In a way which follows customs or usual practices; usually. <i>The leaves are <b>customarily</b> used for animal fodder.</i>
<b>cyclical</b>	Recurring in cycles. <i>The <b>cyclical</b> nature of the cement industry.</i>
<b><a href="#">daily</a></b>	A newspaper published every day except Sunday. <i><b>Daily</b> routine.</i>

<b>day-to-day</b>	The period of time taken by a particular planet (e.g. Mars) to make a complete rotation on its axis.
<b>diurnal</b>	Of or belonging to or active during the day. <i><b>Diurnal</b> and nocturnal offices.</i>
<b>gradually</b>	In a gradual way; slowly; by degrees. <i><b>Gradually</b> his powers of speech returned.</i>
<b>habitually</b>	According to habit or custom. <i>Does he lie <b>habitually</b>.</i>
<b>intermittent</b>	Occurring at irregular intervals; not continuous or steady. <i><b>Intermittent</b> rain showers.</i>
<b>monthly</b>	Once a month; every month. <i>The <b>monthly</b> newsletter.</i>
<b>perennial</b>	A perennial plant. <i>Spring streams rise from <b>perennial</b> springs.</i>
<b>perennially</b>	In a perennial manner; repeatedly. <i>A new blow to the <b>perennially</b> struggling economy.</i>
<b>periodic</b>	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. <i>The <b>periodic</b> visits she made to her father.</i>
<b>periodical</b>	A publication that appears at fixed intervals. <i>She took <b>periodical</b> gulps of her tea.</i>
<b>quarterly</b>	In three month intervals. <i>Interest is compounded <b>quarterly</b>.</i>
<b>regular</b>	A regular member of the armed forces. <i>A <b>regular</b> nincompoop.</i>
<b>routinely</b>	Frequently and without proper consideration of the consequences. <i>Owners <b>routinely</b> flout local laws about restraining and picking up after their pets.</i>
<b>semiannual</b>	Occurring or payable twice each year.
<b>triennial</b>	A visitation of an Anglican diocese by its bishop every three years. <i>The <b>triennial</b> meeting of the Association.</i>
<b>uniformly</b>	With equal space between each or in equal amounts; evenly. <i>Immigrants are not <b>uniformly</b> distributed in the country.</i>
<b>weekly</b>	A newspaper or periodical issued every week. <i>Interviews were given <b>weekly</b>.</i>
<b>yearly</b>	Without missing a year. <i>Rent was paid <b>yearly</b>.</i>
