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Associations of "Regularly" (30 Words)

almanac	A handbook, typically published annually, containing information of general interest or on a sport or pastime.
<u>annual</u>	An annual plant. <i>Annual or yearly income.</i>
annually	Once a year; every year. <i>Sales are increasing by about 17 annually.</i>
<u>biannual</u>	Occurring or payable twice each year. <i>The biannual meeting of the planning committee.</i>
biennial	A plant having a life cycle that normally takes two seasons from germination to death to complete flowering biennials usually bloom and fruit in the second season. <i>They met at biennial conventions.</i>
bimonthly	Done, produced, or occurring twice a month or every two months. <i>The magazine appears bimonthly.</i>
biweekly	Occurring twice a week. <i>A biweekly bulletin.</i>
<u>calendar</u>	Enter something in a calendar or timetable. <i>I have you on my calendar for next Monday.</i>
consistently	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. <i>The vehicle consistently outperforms some of the best competitors.</i>
customarily	In a way which follows customs or usual practices; usually. <i>The leaves are customarily used for animal fodder.</i>
cyclical	Recurring in cycles. <i>The cyclical nature of the cement industry.</i>
<u>daily</u>	A newspaper published every day except Sunday. <i>Daily routine.</i>

day-to-day	The period of time taken by a particular planet (e.g. Mars) to make a complete rotation on its axis.
diurnal	Of or belonging to or active during the day. <i>Diurnal and nocturnal offices.</i>
gradually	In a gradual way; slowly; by degrees. <i>Gradually his powers of speech returned.</i>
habitually	According to habit or custom. <i>Does he lie habitually.</i>
intermittent	Occurring at irregular intervals; not continuous or steady. <i>Intermittent rain showers.</i>
monthly	Once a month; every month. <i>The monthly newsletter.</i>
perennial	A perennial plant. <i>Spring streams rise from perennial springs.</i>
perennially	In a perennial manner; repeatedly. <i>A new blow to the perennially struggling economy.</i>
periodic	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. <i>The periodic visits she made to her father.</i>
periodical	A publication that appears at fixed intervals. <i>She took periodical gulps of her tea.</i>
quarterly	In three month intervals. <i>Interest is compounded quarterly.</i>
regular	A regular member of the armed forces. <i>A regular nincompoop.</i>
routinely	Frequently and without proper consideration of the consequences. <i>Owners routinely flout local laws about restraining and picking up after their pets.</i>
semiannual	Occurring or payable twice each year.
triennial	A visitation of an Anglican diocese by its bishop every three years. <i>The triennial meeting of the Association.</i>
uniformly	With equal space between each or in equal amounts; evenly. <i>Immigrants are not uniformly distributed in the country.</i>
weekly	A newspaper or periodical issued every week. <i>Interviews were given weekly.</i>
yearly	Without missing a year. <i>Rent was paid yearly.</i>
