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• Associations of "Regularly" (30 Words)

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almanac	A handbook, typically published annually, containing information of general interest or on a sport or pastime.
<u>annual</u>	An annual plant. Annual or yearly income.
annually	Once a year; every year. Sales are increasing by about 17 annually .
<u>biannual</u>	Occurring or payable twice each year. The biannual meeting of the planning committee.
biennial	A plant having a life cycle that normally takes two seasons from germination to death to complete flowering biennials usually bloom and fruit in the second season. <i>They met at biennial conventions.</i>
bimonthly	Done, produced, or occurring twice a month or every two months. <i>The magazine appears bimonthly</i> .
biweekly	Occurring twice a week. A biweekly bulletin.
<u>calendar</u>	Enter something in a calendar or timetable. I have you on my calendar for next Monday.
consistently	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. The vehicle consistently outperforms some of the best competitors.
customarily	In a way which follows customs or usual practices; usually. The leaves are customarily used for animal fodder.
cyclical	Recurring in cycles. The cyclical nature of the cement industry.
<u>daily</u>	A newspaper published every day except Sunday. <i>Daily routine</i> .



day-to-day	The period of time taken by a particular planet (e.g. Mars) to make a complete rotation on its axis.
diurnal	Of or belonging to or active during the day. Diurnal and nocturnal offices.
<u>gradually</u>	In a gradual way; slowly; by degrees. <i>Gradually</i> his powers of speech returned.
habitually	According to habit or custom. Does he lie habitually .
<u>intermittent</u>	Occurring at irregular intervals; not continuous or steady. <i>Intermittent</i> rain showers.
monthly	Once a month; every month. <i>The monthly newsletter.</i>
<u>perennial</u>	A perennial plant. Spring streams rise from perennial springs.
perennially	In a perennial manner; repeatedly. A new blow to the perennially struggling economy.
periodic	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. The periodic visits she made to her father.
periodical	A publication that appears at fixed intervals. She took periodical gulps of her tea.
quarterly	In three month intervals. Interest is compounded quarterly .
regular	A regular member of the armed forces. A regular nincompoop.
<u>routinely</u>	Frequently and without proper consideration of the consequences. Owners routinely flout local laws about restraining and picking up after their pets.
semiannual	Occurring or payable twice each year.
triennial	A visitation of an Anglican diocese by its bishop every three years. The triennial meeting of the Association.
uniformly	With equal space between each or in equal amounts; evenly. Immigrants are not uniformly distributed in the country.
<u>weekly</u>	A newspaper or periodical issued every week. Interviews were given weekly .
<u>yearly</u>	Without missing a year. Rent was paid yearly .
