### **Definitions of "Relevance" as a noun**

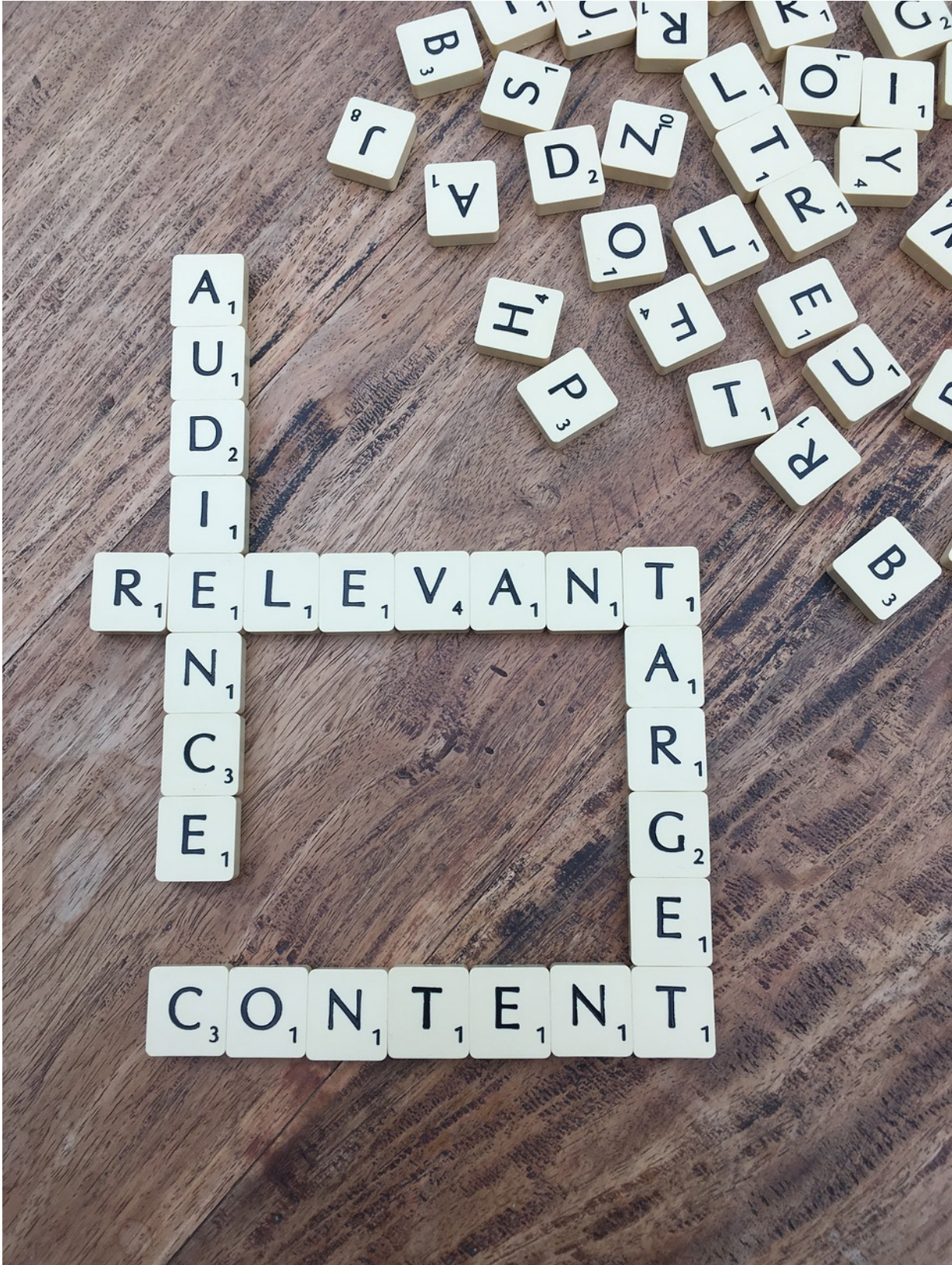
According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “relevance” as a noun can have the following definitions:

## Synonyms of "Relevance" as a noun (1 Word)

**relevancy** The relation of something to the matter at hand.

- *This film has contemporary relevance.*
- *The Web does allow us to produce more articles of relevance to our readers.*



## Associations of "Relevance" (30 Words)

- acknowledgement** A letter confirming receipt of something.  
*There was no **acknowledgement** of the family's trauma.*
- affordable** Inexpensive; reasonably priced.  
***Affordable** homes.*
- applicable** Capable of being applied; having relevance.  
*The same considerations are equally **applicable** to accident claims.*

<b><u>opposite</u></b>	Apt in the circumstances or in relation to something. <i>The observations are <b>opposite</b> to the discussion.</i>
<b>appropriate</b>	Take possession of by force, as after an invasion. <i>The accused had <b>appropriated</b> the property.</i>
<b><u>apropos</u></b>	Introducing a different topic. <i>Your letter arrived <b>apropos</b>.</i>
<b><u>apt</u></b>	Appropriate or suitable in the circumstances. <i>An <b>apt</b> pupil.</i>
<b><u>bearing</u></b>	Characteristic way of bearing one's body. <i>The Point is on a <b>bearing</b> of 015.</i>
<b>befitting</b>	Appropriate to. <i>Behavior <b>befitting</b> a father.</i>
<b>blandness</b>	The quality of being bland and gracious or ingratiating in manner. <i>The <b>blandness</b> of his confession enraged the judge.</i>
<b>congruous</b>	Suitable or appropriate together. <i>This explanation is <b>congruous</b> with earlier observations.</i>
<b>connection</b>	A connecting shape. <i>The plane was late and he missed his <b>connection</b> in Atlanta.</i>
<b>correct</b>	Make right or correct. <i><b>Correct</b> behavior.</i>
<b><u>corrective</u></b>	A device for treating injury or disease. <i>Management were informed so that <b>corrective</b> action could be taken.</i>
<b>dovetail</b>	Fit together tightly as if by means of a dovetail. <i>Plan to enable parents to <b>dovetail</b> their career and family commitments.</i>
<b><u>equally</u></b>	In amounts or parts that are the same in size. <i>Follow up discussion is <b>equally</b> important.</i>
<b>factually</b>	As a fact or based on fact. <i>The evidence is legally and <b>factually</b> insufficient.</i>
<b>felicitous</b>	Well chosen or suited to the circumstances. <i>A <b>felicitous</b> speaker.</i>
<b>germane</b>	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>He asks questions that are <b>germane</b> and central to the issue.</i>
<b><u>opportune</u></b>	Done or occurring at a favourable time; well timed. <i>An <b>opportune</b> arrival.</i>
<b>pertinence</b>	Relevance by virtue of being applicable to the matter at hand.

<b>pertinent</b>	Having precise or logical relevance to the matter at hand. <i>Practitioners must consider all factors <b>pertinent</b> to a situation.</i>
<b>proper</b>	Appropriate for a condition or purpose or occasion or a person's character, needs. <i>After this event three countries will progress to the World Cup <b>proper</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>relate</u></a>	Be relevant to. <i>People who are distantly <b>related</b>.</i>
<b>related</b>	Associated with the specified item or process, especially causally. <i>Painting and the <b>related</b> arts.</i>
<b>relevancy</b>	The relation of something to the matter at hand.
<a href="#"><u>relevant</u></a>	Appropriate to the current time, period, or circumstances; of contemporary interest. <i>Her films are <b>relevant</b> for feminists today.</i>
<b>seemly</b>	Conforming to accepted notions of propriety or good taste; decorous. <i>I felt it was not <b>seemly</b> to observe too closely.</i>
<b>suit</b>	Slang a businessman dressed in a business suit. <i>What time would <b>suit</b> you.</i>
<a href="#"><u>suitable</u></a>	Meant or adapted for an occasion or use. <i>These toys are not <b>suitable</b> for children under five.</i>
