# **Conjugate Relieve**

## **Relieve in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I relieve	We <b>relieve</b>
You <b>relieve</b>	You <b>relieve</b>
He/She/It relieves	They <b>relieve</b>

## **Relieve in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am relieving	We <b>are relieving</b>
You <b>are relieving</b>	You <b>are relieving</b>
He/She/It is relieving	They are relieving

## **Relieve in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have relieved	We have relieved
You have relieved	You have relieved
He/She/It has relieved	They have relieved

## **Relieve in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been relieving	We have been relieving
You <b>have been relieving</b>	You have been relieving
He/She/It has been relieving	They have been relieving

## **Relieve in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I relieved	We <b>relieved</b>
You <b>relieved</b>	You <b>relieved</b>
He/She/It <b>relieved</b>	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{relieved}}$

#### **Relieve in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was relieving	We were relieving
You <b>were relieving</b>	You <b>were relieving</b>
He/She/It was relieving	They were relieving

#### **Relieve in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had relieved	We had relieved
You had relieved	You had relieved
He/She/It had relieved	They had relieved

## **Relieve in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been relieving	We had been relieving
You <b>had been relieving</b>	You had been relieving
He/She/It had been relieving	They had been relieving

## **Relieve in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will relieve	We <b>will relieve</b>
You <b>will relieve</b>	You <b>will relieve</b>
He/She/It will relieve	They will relieve

## **Relieve in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be relieving	We <b>will be relieving</b>
You <b>will be relieving</b>	You will be relieving
He/She/It will be relieving	They will be relieving
