Infinitive	to reluctate
Present Tense	reluctate / reluctates
Past Tense	reluctated
Present Participle	reluctating
Past Participle	reluctated

# **Conjugate Reluctate**

### **Reluctate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I reluctate	We <b>reluctate</b>
You <b>reluctate</b>	You <b>reluctate</b>
He/She/It reluctates	They <b>reluctate</b>

## **Reluctate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am reluctating	We are reluctating
You are reluctating	You <b>are reluctating</b>
He/She/It is reluctating	They are reluctating

#### **Reluctate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have reluctated	We have reluctated
You have reluctated	You have reluctated
He/She/It has reluctated	They have reluctated

## **Reluctate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been reluctating	We have been reluctating
You have been reluctating	You have been reluctating
He/She/It has been reluctating	They have been reluctating

## **Reluctate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I reluctated	We <b>reluctated</b>
You <b>reluctated</b>	You <b>reluctated</b>
He/She/It reluctated	They <b>reluctated</b>

#### **Reluctate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was reluctating	We were reluctating
You were reluctating	You were reluctating
He/She/It was reluctating	They were reluctating

#### **Reluctate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had reluctated	We had reluctated
You had reluctated	You had reluctated
He/She/It had reluctated	They had reluctated

#### **Reluctate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been reluctating	We had been reluctating
You <b>had been reluctating</b>	You <b>had been reluctating</b>
He/She/It had been reluctating	They had been reluctating

## **Reluctate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will reluctate	We <b>will reluctate</b>
You <b>will reluctate</b>	You <b>will reluctate</b>
He/She/It will reluctate	They will reluctate

## **Reluctate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be reluctating	We will be reluctating
You <b>will be reluctating</b>	You will be reluctating
He/She/It will be reluctating	They will be reluctating

## **Reluctate in Future Perfect Tense**

## **Reluctate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been reluctating	We will have been reluctating
You <b>will have been reluctating</b>	You will have been reluctating
He/She/It will have been reluctating	They will have been reluctating
