<a href="#">ceaseless</a>	Constant and unending. <i>The <b>ceaseless</b> thunder of surf.</i>
<a href="#">consistent</a>	Marked by an orderly logical and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>The parents are being <b>consistent</b> and firm in their reactions.</i>
<b>constant</b>	A number expressing a relation or property which remains the same in all circumstances, or for the same substance under the same conditions. <i>A man <b>constant</b> in adherence to his ideals.</i>
<a href="#">continually</a>	Without interruption; constantly. <i>I was <b>continually</b> moving around.</i>
<b>continue</b>	Continue talking. <i>He was unable to <b>continue</b> with his job.</i>
<b>continuous</b>	Forming an unbroken whole; without interruption. <i>A <b>continuous</b> row of warehouses.</i>
<a href="#">eternal</a>	Lasting or existing forever; without end. <i><b>Eternal</b> quarreling.</i>
<a href="#">ever</a>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>Did you <b>ever</b> smoke.</i>
<b>everlasting</b>	Eternity. <i>An <b>everlasting</b> reminder of this evening.</i>
<a href="#">forever</a>	Continually. <i>Parenting is a <b>forever</b> job.</i>
<a href="#">grinding</a>	A harsh and strident sound as of the grinding of gears. <i>Crush it and add it to the honey with a <b>grinding</b> of pepper and salt.</i>
<a href="#">immortal</a>	An immortal being especially a god of ancient Greece or Rome. <i>Shakespeare is one of the <b>immortals</b>.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Night and day we live with the <b>incessant</b> noise of the city.</i>

<b>incessantly</b>	Without interruption; constantly. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>lag</b>	Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. <i><b>Lag</b> pipes.</i>
<b>linger</b>	Be about. <i>The shy student <b>lingered</b> in the corner.</i>
<b>onwards</b>	In a forward direction.
<b>persevere</b>	Continue in a course of action even in the face of difficulty or with little or no indication of success. <i>His family <b>persevered</b> with his treatment.</i>
<b>persist</b>	Be persistent refuse to stop. <i>He <b>persisted</b> to call me every night.</i>
<b>residual</b>	Relating to or indicating a remainder. <i><b>Residual</b> quantity.</i>
<b>rest</b>	Give a rest to. <i>The car accelerates rapidly from <b>rest</b>.</i>
<b>sojourn</b>	A temporary stay. <i>She had <b>sojourned</b> once in Egypt.</i>
<b>stay</b>	Stay put in a certain place. <i>Minton invited him to <b>stay</b> the night.</i>
<b>tarry</b>	Be about. <i>A length of <b>tarry</b> rope.</i>
<b>timeless</b>	Not affected by the passage of time or changes in fashion. <i>Antiques add to the <b>timeless</b> atmosphere of the dining room.</i>
<b>unaltered</b>	Remaining in an original state. <i>Persisting <b>unaltered</b> through time.</i>
<b>unceasingly</b>	With unflagging resolve.
<b>unchanged</b>	Not changed; unaltered. <i>The causes that produced them have remained <b>unchanged</b>.</i>
<b>unchecked</b>	Not examined or checked. <i>An <b>unchecked</b> temper.</i>
<b>unvaried</b>	Not involving change. <i>A plain <b>unvaried</b> diet.</i>
