Associations of "Remained" (30 Words)

ceaseless	Constant and unending. <i>The ceaseless thunder of surf.</i>
consistent	Marked by an orderly logical and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>The parents are being consistent and firm in their reactions.</i>
constant	A number expressing a relation or property which remains the same in all circumstances, or for the same substance under the same conditions. <i>A man constant in adherence to his ideals.</i>
continually	Without interruption; constantly. <i>I was continually moving around.</i>
continue	Continue talking. <i>He was unable to continue with his job.</i>
continuous	Forming an unbroken whole; without interruption. <i>A continuous row of warehouses.</i>
eternal	Lasting or existing forever; without end. <i>Eternal quarreling.</i>
ever	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>Did you ever smoke.</i>
everlasting	Eternity. <i>An everlasting reminder of this evening.</i>
forever	Continually. <i>Parenting is a forever job.</i>
grinding	A harsh and strident sound as of the grinding of gears. <i>Crush it and add it to the honey with a grinding of pepper and salt.</i>
immortal	An immortal being especially a god of ancient Greece or Rome. <i>Shakespeare is one of the immortals.</i>
incessant	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Night and day we live with the incessant noise of the city.</i>

incessantly	Without interruption; constantly. <i>She talked about him incessantly.</i>
lag	Cover with lagging to prevent heat loss. <i>Lag pipes.</i>
linger	Be about. <i>The shy student lingered in the corner.</i>
onwards	In a forward direction.
persevere	Continue in a course of action even in the face of difficulty or with little or no indication of success. <i>His family persevered with his treatment.</i>
persist	Be persistent refuse to stop. <i>He persisted to call me every night.</i>
residual	Relating to or indicating a remainder. <i>Residual quantity.</i>
rest	Give a rest to. <i>The car accelerates rapidly from rest.</i>
sojourn	A temporary stay. <i>She had sojourned once in Egypt.</i>
stay	Stay put in a certain place. <i>Minton invited him to stay the night.</i>
tarry	Be about. <i>A length of tarry rope.</i>
timeless	Not affected by the passage of time or changes in fashion. <i>Antiques add to the timeless atmosphere of the dining room.</i>
unaltered	Remaining in an original state. <i>Persisting unaltered through time.</i>
unceasingly	With unflagging resolve.
unchanged	Not changed; unaltered. <i>The causes that produced them have remained unchanged.</i>
unchecked	Not examined or checked. <i>An unchecked temper.</i>
unvaried	Not involving change. <i>A plain unvaried diet.</i>
