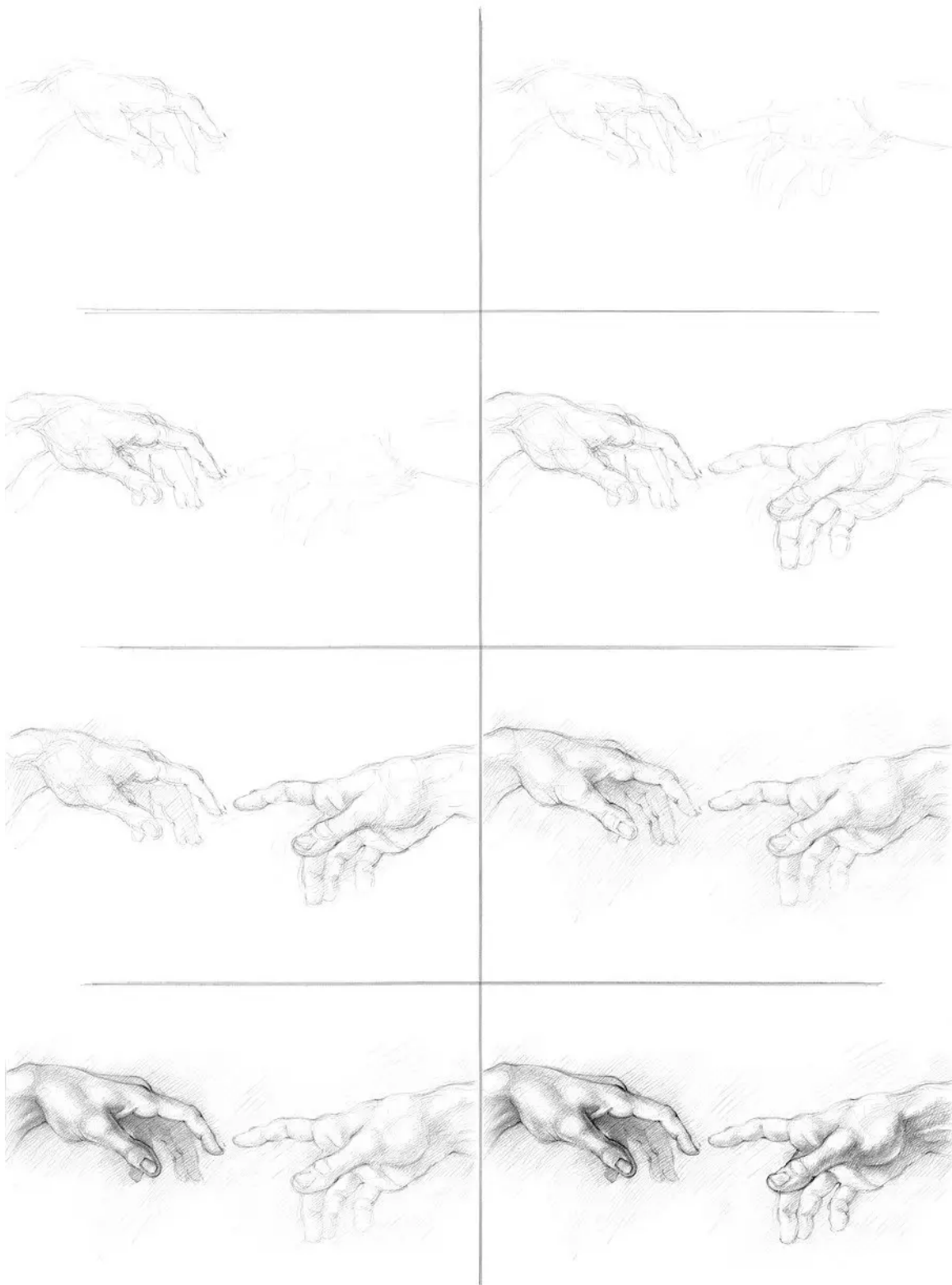

### Definitions of "Remake" as a noun

- *Creation that is created again or anew.*
- *A film or piece of music that has been filmed or recorded again.*



## Synonyms of "Remake" as a noun (8 Words)

<b>amelioration</b>	The act of making something better; improvement. <i>Progress brings with it the <b>amelioration</b> of the human condition.</i>
<b>betterment</b>	A change for the better; progress in development. <i>They believed that what they were doing was vital for the <b>betterment</b> of society.</i>
<b>correction</b>	The act of offering an improvement to replace a mistake; setting right. <i>The incompatibility of justice and <b>correction</b> as penal objectives has long been the major unsolved problem of penal practice.</i>
<b>improvement</b>	The action of improving or being improved. <i>An <b>improvement</b> in East West relations.</i>
<b>rectification</b>	Determination of the length of a curve; finding a straight line equal in length to a given curve. <i><b>Rectifications</b> are sent to the client for feedback.</i>
<u><b>refinement</b></u>	The improvement or clarification of something by the making of small changes. <i>A man of intellectual <b>refinement</b>.</i>
<b>rehabilitation</b>	The conversion of wasteland into land suitable for use of habitation or cultivation. <i>A posthumous <b>rehabilitation</b> of the activist.</i>
<b>remaking</b>	Creation that is created again or anew.

- *It is a remake of an old film.*

## Remake as a Verb

### Definitions of "Remake" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "remake" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make new.*
- *Make (something) again or differently.*

## Synonyms of "Remake" as a verb (12 Words)

<b><u>ameliorate</u></b>	Make (something bad or unsatisfactory) better. <i>The reform did much to <b>ameliorate</b> living standards.</i>
<b>better</b>	Get better. <i>She had almost <b>bettered</b> him at archery.</i>
<b>correct</b>	Make right or correct. <i>Engineers will work to <b>correct</b> the effects of air resistance.</i>
<b>improve</b>	Get better. <i>The weather <b>improved</b> toward evening.</i>
<b>make better</b>	Appear to begin an activity.
<b>make over</b>	Make or cause to be or to become.
<b>mend</b>	Improve (an unpleasant situation). <i>Foot injuries can take months to <b>mend</b>.</i>
<b>rectify</b>	Find a straight line equal in length to (a curve). <i><b>Rectify</b> a curve.</i>
<b><u>redo</u></b>	Do (something) again or differently. <i>A whole day's work has to be <b>redone</b>.</i>
<b>refashion</b>	Make new. <i>The industry reshaped and <b>refashioned</b> itself.</i>
<b><u>refine</u></b>	Improve or perfect by pruning or polishing. <i><b>Refine</b> sugar.</i>
<b>rehabilitate</b>	Reinstall politically. <i>With the fall of the government many former dissidents were <b>rehabilitated</b>.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Remake" as a verb

- *The bed would be more comfortable if it were remade.*
