## **The Forms of Remand**

Infinitive	to remand
Present Tense	remand / remands
Past Tense	remanded
Present Participle	remanding
Past Participle	remanded

# **Conjugate Remand**

### **Remand in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>remand</b>	We <b>remand</b>
You <b>remand</b>	You <b>remand</b>
He/She/It <b>remands</b>	They <b>remand</b>

### **Remand in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am remanding	We are remanding
You <b>are remanding</b>	You are remanding
He/She/It is remanding	They are remanding

#### **Remand in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have remanded	We have remanded
You have remanded	You have remanded
He/She/It has remanded	They have remanded

### **Remand in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been remanding	We have been remanding
You have been remanding	You have been remanding
He/She/It has been remanding	They have been remanding

### **Remand in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>remanded</b>	We <b>remanded</b>
You <b>remanded</b>	You <b>remanded</b>
He/She/It <b>remanded</b>	They <b>remanded</b>

#### **Remand in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was remanding	We were remanding
You <b>were remanding</b>	You were remanding
He/She/It was remanding	They were remanding

#### **Remand in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had remanded	We had remanded
You had remanded	You had remanded
He/She/It had remanded	They had remanded

#### **Remand in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been remanding	We had been remanding
You <b>had been remanding</b>	You had been remanding
He/She/It had been remanding	They had been remanding

### **Remand in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will remand	We will remand
You <b>will remand</b>	You <b>will remand</b>
He/She/It will remand	They will remand

### **Remand in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be remanding	We will be remanding
You <b>will be remanding</b>	You will be remanding
He/She/It will be remanding	They will be remanding

### **Remand in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have remanded	We will have remanded
You <b>will have remanded</b>	You will have remanded
He/She/It will have remanded	They will have remanded

### **Remand in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been remanding	We <b>will have been remanding</b>
You <b>will have been remanding</b>	You <b>will have been remanding</b>
He/She/It will have been remanding	They will have been remanding
