Remediate as a Verb

Definitions of "Remediate" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "remediate" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Set straight or right.
- Restore by reversing or stopping environmental damage.
- Provide a remedy for; redress or make right.





Synonyms of "Remediate" as a verb (4 Words)

amend Make amendments to.

A few things had gone wrong but these had been ${\it amend}{\it ed}.$

rectify Make right or correct.

Rectify the calculation.

 $\begin{array}{c} \textbf{remedy} & \textbf{Set straight or right.} \\ \textbf{\textit{Remedy} his illness.} \end{array}$

repair Restore (something damaged, faulty, or worn) to a good condition. *This treatment repaired my health.*





Usage Examples of "Remediate" as a verb

- Contaminated land would be remediated and bought back into beneficial use.
- The most serious flaws are easy to remediate.
- Use of plants to remediate soils contaminated with heavy metals.
