## **Repel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

### **Repel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am repelling	We <b>are repelling</b>
You <b>are repelling</b>	You <b>are repelling</b>
He/She/It is repelling	They are repelling

#### **Repel in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have repelled	We have repelled
You have repelled	You have repelled
He/She/It has repelled	They have repelled

## **Repel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been repelling	We have been repelling
You <b>have been repelling</b>	You have been repelling
He/She/It has been repelling	They have been repelling

#### **Repel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I repelled	We <b>repelled</b>
You <b>repelled</b>	You <b>repelled</b>
He/She/It repelled	They <b>repelled</b>

#### **Repel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was repelling	We were repelling
You were repelling	You were repelling
He/She/It was repelling	They were repelling

## **Repel in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had repelled	We had repelled
You had repelled	You had repelled
He/She/It had repelled	They had repelled

## **Repel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been repelling	We had been repelling
You <b>had been repelling</b>	You had been repelling
He/She/It had been repelling	They had been repelling

## **Repel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will repel	We <b>will repel</b>
You <b>will repel</b>	You <b>will repel</b>
He/She/It will repel	They will repel

## **Repel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be repelling	We will be repelling
You <b>will be repelling</b>	You will be repelling
He/She/It will be repelling	They will be repelling

## **Repel in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have repelledWe will have repelledYou will have repelledYou will have repelledHe/She/It will have repelledThey will have repelled

## **Repel in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been repelling	We <b>will have been repelling</b>
You <b>will have been repelling</b>	You <b>will have been repelling</b>
He/She/It will have been repelling	They will have been repelling
