Past Tense	<b>questioned</b>
Present Participle	<b>questioning</b>
Past Participle	<b>questioned</b>

**Question in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **requestion**                      We **requestion**  
You **requestion**                You **requestion**  
He/She/It **requestions**      They **requestion**

**Requestion in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am requestioning**            We **are requestioning**  
You **are requestioning**        You **are requestioning**  
He/She/It **is requestioning**    They **are requestioning**

**Requestion in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have requestioned**            We **have requestioned**  
You **have requestioned**        You **have requestioned**  
He/She/It **has requestioned**    They **have requestioned**

**Requestion in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been requestioning**      We **have been requestioning**  
You **have been requestioning**    You **have been requestioning**  
He/She/It **has been requestioning**    They **have been requestioning**

**Requestion in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **requestioned**                      We **requestioned**  
You **requestioned**                You **requestioned**  
He/She/It **requestioned**        They **requestioned**

**Requestion in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was questioning                      We were questioning  
You were questioning                You were questioning  
He/She/It was questioning        They were questioning

**Question in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had questioned                      We had questioned  
You had questioned                    You had questioned  
He/She/It had questioned        They had questioned

**Question in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been questioning                We had been questioning  
You had been questioning              You had been questioning  
He/She/It had been questioning    They had been questioning

**Question in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will question                        We will question  
You will question                      You will question  
He/She/It will question            They will question

**Question in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be questioning                    We will be questioning  
You will be questioning                You will be questioning  
He/She/It will be questioning        They will be questioning

**Question in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have questioned**

**We will have questioned**

**You will have questioned**

**You will have questioned**

**He/She/It will have questioned**

**They will have questioned**

**Question in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been questioning**

**We will have been questioning**

**You will have been questioning**

**You will have been questioning**

**He/She/It will have been questioning**

**They will have been questioning**
