Singular Plural

I research
You research
He/She/It researches They research

Research in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am researching We are researching
You are researching You are researching
He/She/It is researching They are researching

Research in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have researched We have researched You have researched He/She/It has researched They have researched

Research in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been researching
You have been researching
He/She/It has been researching
They have been researching

Research in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I researched We researched
You researched You researched
He/She/It researched They researched

Research in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was researching We were researching
You were researching You were researching
He/She/It was researching They were researching

Research in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had researched We had researched
You had researched You had researched
He/She/It had researched They had researched

Research in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been researching
You had been researching
He/She/It had been researching
They had been researching

Research in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will research
You will research
He/She/It will research
They will research

Research in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be researching
You will be researching
He/She/It will be researching
They will be researching

Research in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have researched We will have researched You will have researched He/She/It will have researched They will have researched

Research in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been researching
You will have been researching
He/She/It will have been researching
They will have been researching
