<b>creativeness</b>	The ability to create.
<b>creativity</b>	The use of imagination or original ideas to create something; inventiveness. <i>Firms are keen to encourage <b>creativity</b>.</i>
<b>dexterous</b>	Showing or having skill, especially with the hands. <i>A <b>dexterous</b> keyboard player.</i>
<b>dextrous</b>	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands.
<b>genius</b>	Unusual mental ability. <i>He sees Adams as the man's evil <b>genius</b>.</i>
<b><u>groundbreaking</u></b>	The ceremonial breaking of the ground to formally begin a construction project. <i><b>Groundbreaking</b> research into fertility problems.</i>
<b>ingenious</b>	(of a machine or idea) cleverly and originally devised and well suited to its purpose. <i>He was <b>ingenious</b> enough to overcome the limited budget.</i>
<b>innovative</b>	Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before. <i><b>Innovative</b> members of the artistic community.</i>
<b>intelligent</b>	Having the capacity for thought and reason especially to a high degree. <i>Is there <b>intelligent</b> life in the universe.</i>
<b><u>invention</u></b>	Creative ability. <i>His powers of <b>invention</b> were rather limited.</i>
<b><u>inventive</u></b>	(used of persons or artifacts) marked by independence and creativity in thought or action. <i>Had an <b>inventive</b> turn of mind.</i>
<b><u>masterful</u></b>	Having or revealing supreme mastery or skill. <i><b>Masterful</b> technique.</i>
<b>maven</b>	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>The <b>maven</b> of vintage furniture.</i>
<b><u>originality</u></b>	The quality of being novel or unusual. <i>He congratulated her on the <b>originality</b> of her costume.</i>
<b>outwit</b>	Beat through cleverness and wit. <i>Ray had <b>outwitted</b> many an opponent.</i>
<b>prodigy</b>	An impressive or wonderful example of a particular quality. <i>She is a chess <b>prodigy</b>.</i>

<b>sagacity</b>	The mental ability to understand and discriminate between relations. <i>A man of great political <b>sagacity</b>.</i>
<b>shrewd</b>	(especially of weather) piercingly cold. <i>She was <b>shrewd</b> enough to guess the motive behind his gesture.</i>
<b>skilled</b>	(of work) requiring special abilities or training. <i>A lab technician <b>skilled</b> in electronics.</i>
<b>slyly</b>	In a way that suggests some secret knowledge that may be harmful or embarrassing; knowingly. <i>He <b>slyly</b> manipulates votes.</i>
<b>smart</b>	Intelligence; acumen. <i>He gave the dog a <b>smart</b> blow.</i>
<b>virtuoso</b>	Having or revealing supreme mastery or skill. <i><b>Virtuoso</b> guitar playing.</i>
<b>wizardry</b>	Great skill in a particular area of activity. <i>Plless s <b>wizardry</b> with a bat.</i>
