recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>A recipient country.</i>
<u>reciprocate</u>	Feel (affection or love) for someone in the same way that they feel it for oneself. <i>The favour was reciprocated.</i>
<u>relay</u>	A signal or broadcast transmitted by a relay. The wagons were pulled by relay s of horses.
replication	The repetition of a sound resulting from reflection of the sound waves. A crucial step in cold virus replication s.
reply	A statement either spoken or written that is made to reply to a question or request or criticism or accusation. <i>I am writing in reply to your letter.</i>
response	The manner in which something is greeted. The throttle response from the 1870 cc engine is almost petrol sharp.
<u>responsive</u>	(of a section of liturgy) using responses. A flexible service that is responsive to changing social patterns.
<u>retort</u>	Answer back. The answer they make to us may very easily be retort ed.
riposte	A counterattack made immediately after successfully parrying the opponents lunge. You ve got a strange sense of honour Grant riposte d.
