address	Put an address on an envelope. <i>A fundamental problem has still to be addressed.</i>
airmail	Send or transport by airmail. <i>I have a sheaf of letters to airmail.</i>
albedo	The ratio of reflected to incident light. <i>The lunar maria have a lower albedo than the surrounding terrain.</i>
answer	Give the correct answer or solution to. <i>Entrepreneurship is necessary to answer the needs of national and international markets.</i>
coolly	In a way that shows a lack of any excitement, anxiety, or excessive emotion. <i>She was coolly detached.</i>
correspondence	(mathematics) an attribute of a shape or relation; exact reflection of form on opposite sides of a dividing line or plane. <i>Sophie wrote a letter to Rosamund with whom she kept up a regular correspondence.</i>
email	Send an email to someone. <i>I got three emails from my mother today.</i>
envelope	A natural covering (as by a fluid). <i>The external envelope of the swimming pool.</i>
flexibly	In a way that can change so as to adapt to different circumstances. <i>The ability of governments to respond flexibly to changing economic circumstances.</i>
mail	A single delivery or collection of mail. <i>You can order by mail.</i>
mailbox	A computer file in which email messages received by a particular user are stored.

mailing	The action or process of sending something by mail. <i>The postmark indicates the time of mailing.</i>
oh	A midwestern state in north central United States in the Great Lakes region.
pardon	Grant a pardon to. <i>Ford pardoned Nixon.</i>
post	A goalpost. <i>Post a sign.</i>
postage	A small adhesive token stuck on a letter or package to indicate that that postal fees have been paid. <i>Proof of postage is required.</i>
postal	Of or relating to the system for delivering mail. <i>A postal ballot.</i>
react	Show a response or a reaction to something. <i>The shares reacted to 222p before rallying to 228p.</i>
recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>A recipient country.</i>
reciprocate	Feel (affection or love) for someone in the same way that they feel it for oneself. <i>The favour was reciprocated.</i>
relay	A signal or broadcast transmitted by a relay. <i>The wagons were pulled by relays of horses.</i>
replication	The repetition of a sound resulting from reflection of the sound waves. <i>A crucial step in cold virus replications.</i>
reply	A statement either spoken or written that is made to reply to a question or request or criticism or accusation. <i>I am writing in reply to your letter.</i>
response	The manner in which something is greeted. <i>The throttle response from the 1870 cc engine is almost petrol sharp.</i>
responsive	(of a section of liturgy) using responses. <i>A flexible service that is responsive to changing social patterns.</i>
retort	Answer back. <i>The answer they make to us may very easily be retorted.</i>
riposte	A counterattack made immediately after successfully parrying the opponents lunge. <i>You ve got a strange sense of honour Grant riposted.</i>
