<b>address</b>	Put an address on an envelope. <i>A fundamental problem has still to be <b>addressed</b>.</i>
<b>airmail</b>	Send or transport by airmail. <i>I have a sheaf of letters to <b>airmail</b>.</i>
<b>albedo</b>	The ratio of reflected to incident light. <i>The lunar maria have a lower <b>albedo</b> than the surrounding terrain.</i>
<b>answer</b>	Give the correct answer or solution to. <i>Entrepreneurship is necessary to <b>answer</b> the needs of national and international markets.</i>
<b>coolly</b>	In a way that shows a lack of any excitement, anxiety, or excessive emotion. <i>She was <b>coolly</b> detached.</i>
<b><a href="#">correspondence</a></b>	(mathematics) an attribute of a shape or relation; exact reflection of form on opposite sides of a dividing line or plane. <i>Sophie wrote a letter to Rosamund with whom she kept up a regular <b>correspondence</b>.</i>
<b>email</b>	Send an email to someone. <i>I got three <b>emails</b> from my mother today.</i>
<b><a href="#">envelope</a></b>	A natural covering (as by a fluid). <i>The external <b>envelope</b> of the swimming pool.</i>
<b>flexibly</b>	In a way that can change so as to adapt to different circumstances. <i>The ability of governments to respond <b>flexibly</b> to changing economic circumstances.</i>
<b>mail</b>	A single delivery or collection of mail. <i>You can order by <b>mail</b>.</i>
<b>mailbox</b>	A computer file in which email messages received by a particular user are stored.

<b>mailing</b>	The action or process of sending something by mail. <i>The postmark indicates the time of <b>mailing</b>.</i>
<b>oh</b>	A midwestern state in north central United States in the Great Lakes region.
<b>pardon</b>	Grant a pardon to. <i>Ford <b>pardoned</b> Nixon.</i>
<b>post</b>	A goalpost. <i><b>Post</b> a sign.</i>
<b>postage</b>	A small adhesive token stuck on a letter or package to indicate that that postal fees have been paid. <i>Proof of <b>postage</b> is required.</i>
<b>postal</b>	Of or relating to the system for delivering mail. <i>A <b>postal</b> ballot.</i>
<b>react</b>	Show a response or a reaction to something. <i>The shares <b>reacted</b> to 222p before rallying to 228p.</i>
<b>recipient</b>	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>A <b>recipient</b> country.</i>
<b>reciprocate</b>	Feel (affection or love) for someone in the same way that they feel it for oneself. <i>The favour was <b>reciprocated</b>.</i>
<b>relay</b>	A signal or broadcast transmitted by a relay. <i>The wagons were pulled by <b>relays</b> of horses.</i>
<b>replication</b>	The repetition of a sound resulting from reflection of the sound waves. <i>A crucial step in cold virus <b>replications</b>.</i>
<b>reply</b>	A statement either spoken or written that is made to reply to a question or request or criticism or accusation. <i>I am writing in <b>reply</b> to your letter.</i>
<b>response</b>	The manner in which something is greeted. <i>The throttle <b>response</b> from the 1870 cc engine is almost petrol sharp.</i>
<b>responsive</b>	(of a section of liturgy) using responses. <i>A flexible service that is <b>responsive</b> to changing social patterns.</i>
<b>retort</b>	Answer back. <i>The answer they make to us may very easily be <b>retorted</b>.</i>
<b>riposte</b>	A counterattack made immediately after successfully parrying the opponents lunge. <i>You ve got a strange sense of honour Grant <b>riposted</b>.</i>
