<u>react</u>	Show a response or a reaction to something. The shares <b>react</b> ed to 222p before rallying to 228p.
recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>A recipient country.</i>
<u>reciprocate</u>	Feel (affection or love) for someone in the same way that they feel it for oneself. <i>The favour was reciprocated.</i>
<u>relay</u>	A signal or broadcast transmitted by a relay. The wagons were pulled by <b>relay</b> s of horses.
replication	The repetition of a sound resulting from reflection of the sound waves. A crucial step in cold virus <b>replication</b> s.
reply	A statement either spoken or written that is made to reply to a question or request or criticism or accusation. <i>I am writing in <b>reply</b> to your letter.</i>
response	The manner in which something is greeted. The throttle <b>response</b> from the 1870 cc engine is almost petrol sharp.
<u>responsive</u>	(of a section of liturgy) using responses. A flexible service that is <b>responsive</b> to changing social patterns.
<u>retort</u>	Answer back. The answer they make to us may very easily be <b>retort</b> ed.
riposte	A counterattack made immediately after successfully parrying the opponents lunge. You ve got a strange sense of honour Grant <b>riposte</b> d.



send	Send a message or letter. <b>Send</b> your document as a PDF attachment.
sender	A person who sends or transmits a message, letter, email, etc. <i>Evidence submitted late will be returned to the <b>sender</b>.</i>
spam	A canned meat made largely from pork. An autogenerated <b>spam</b> website.
