## Restart as a Verb

### Definitions of "Restart" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "restart" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Start again.*
- *Take up or begin anew.*
- *Start an engine again, for example.*



## Synonyms of "Restart" as a verb (10 Words)

<b>begin again</b>	Be the first item or point, constitute the beginning or start, come first in a series.
<b>come back to</b>	Exist or occur in a certain point in a series.
<b>pick up again</b>	Look for and gather.
<b>re-start</b>	Take up or begin anew.
<b>recommence</b>	Cause to start anew. <i>The enemy <b>recommenced</b> hostilities after a few days of quiet.</i>
<b>reopen</b>	Open again or anew. <i>After being renovated the house was <b>reopened</b> to the public.</i>
<b>resume</b>	Take up or begin anew. <i>The judge <b>resumed</b> his seat.</i>
<b>return to</b>	Return to a previous position in mathematics.
<b>start again</b>	Bulge outward.
<b>take up again</b>	Pick out, select, or choose from a number of alternatives.



## Usage Examples of "Restart" as a verb

- *He tried to restart his stalled car.*
- *The talks will restart in September.*
