come back to Exist or occur in a certain point in a series.

pick up again Look for and gather.

re-start Take up or begin anew.

recommence Cause to start anew.

The enemy **recommence**d hostilities after a few days of quiet.

reopen Open again or anew.

After being renovated the house was **reopen**ed to the public.

Take up or begin anew.

The judge **resume**d his seat.

return to Return to a previous position in mathematics.

start again Bulge outward.

take up again Pick out, select, or choose from a number of alternatives.
