- Thinking again about a choice previously made.
- A reassessment, especially one that results in changes being made.





Synonyms of "Rethink" as a noun (7 Words)

afterthought Something that is thought of or added later.

The garage was an **afterthought**.

reappraisal

An assessment of something or someone again or in a different way.

Policies can be subject to internal **reappraisal**.

The consideration or assessment of something again, in the light of new

reassessment or different factors.

Her conclusion helped lead to a fundamental **reassessment** of dyslexia.

A consideration of a topic (as in a meeting) with a view to changing an

 ${\bf reconsideration} \ {\bf earlier} \ {\bf decision}.$

A careful **reconsideration** of the existing approaches.
