Definitions of "Rethink" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “rethink” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Thinking again about a choice previously made.*
- *A reassessment, especially one that results in changes being made.*



Synonyms of "Rethink" as a noun (7 Words)

- afterthought** Something that is thought of or added later.
*The garage was an **afterthought**.*
- reappraisal** An assessment of something or someone again or in a different way.
*Policies can be subject to internal **reappraisal**.*
- reassessment** The consideration or assessment of something again, in the light of new or different factors.
*Her conclusion helped lead to a fundamental **reassessment** of dyslexia.*
- reconsideration** A consideration of a topic (as in a meeting) with a view to changing an earlier decision.
*A careful **reconsideration** of the existing approaches.*

- review** A periodical that publishes critical essays on current affairs or literature or art.
*All areas of the company will come under **review**.*
- second thought** The fielding position of the player on a baseball team who is stationed near the second of the bases in the infield.
- thinking over** The process of using your mind to consider something carefully.



Usage Examples of "Rethink" as a noun

- *A last-minute rethink of their tactics.*



Rethink as a Verb

Definitions of "Rethink" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "rethink" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Consider or assess (something, especially a course of action) again, especially in order to change it.*
- *Change one's mind.*



Synonyms of "Rethink" as a verb (10 Words)

have another think about

Be confronted with.

look at in a different light

Have a certain outward or facial expression.

re-examine

Question after cross-examination by opposing counsel.

reappraise

Appraise or assess again or in a different way.

*Homes in our town are **reappraised** every five years and taxes are increased accordingly.*

reassess

Revise or renew one's assessment.

*We have decided to **reassess** our timetable.*

review

Hold a review of troops.

*The Attorney General asked the court to **review** the sentence.*

revise

Revise or reorganize especially for the purpose of updating and improving.

Revise your lecture notes on the topic.

take another look at

Be seized or affected in a specified way.

think better of

Expect, believe, or suppose.

think over

Judge or regard; look upon; judge.
