- Imitative of a style or fashion from the recent past.
- Affecting things past.





Synonyms of "Retro" as an adjective (7 Words)

<u>evocative</u>	Serving to bring to mind- Wilder Hobson. The building s cramped interiors are highly evocative of past centuries.
ex post facto	Out of fashion.
in period style	Currently fashionable.
<u>nostalgic</u>	Feeling, evoking, or characterized by nostalgia. <i>He remained</i> nostalgic about the good old days.
olde worlde	Attractively old-fashioned (but not necessarily authentic.
period	Belonging to or characteristic of a past historical time, especially in style or design. <i>An attractive and beautifully modernized</i> period <i>house</i> .



<u>retroactive</u>

Descriptive of any event or stimulus or process that has an effect on the effects of events or stimuli or process that occurred previously. *A big retroactive tax increase.*



Usage Examples of "Retro" as an adjective

- Retro pay.
- *Retro 60s fashions.*
