Past Tense	<b>revigorated</b>
Present Participle	<b>revigorating</b>
Past Participle	<b>revigorated</b>

**Plural**

I **revigorate**                      We **revigorate**  
You **revigorate**                    You **revigorate**  
He/She/It **revigorates**      They **revigorate**

**Revigorate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am revigorating**                We **are revigorating**  
You **are revigorating**            You **are revigorating**  
He/She/It **is revigorating**      They **are revigorating**

**Revigorate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have revigorated**                We **have revigorated**  
You **have revigorated**            You **have revigorated**  
He/She/It **has revigorated**      They **have revigorated**

**Revigorate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been revigorating**        We **have been revigorating**  
You **have been revigorating**      You **have been revigorating**  
He/She/It **has been revigorating**      They **have been revigorating**

You **revigorated**                    You **revigorated**  
He/She/It **revigorated**          They **revigorated**

I was revigorating      We were revigorating  
You were revigorating      You were revigorating  
He/She/It was revigorating      They were revigorating

I had revigorated      We had revigorated  
You had revigorated      You had revigorated  
He/She/It had revigorated      They had revigorated

I had been revigorating      We had been revigorating  
You had been revigorating      You had been revigorating  
He/She/It had been revigorating      They had been revigorating

I will revigorate      We will revigorate  
You will revigorate      You will revigorate  
He/She/It will revigorate      They will revigorate

**Revigorate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I will be revigorating      We will be revigorating  
You will be revigorating      You will be revigorating  
He/She/It will be revigorating      They will be revigorating

**We will have revigorated**

**You will have revigorated**

**You will have revigorated**

**He/She/It will have revigorated** **They will have revigorated**
