Definitions of "Rework" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “rework” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Use again in altered form.*
- *Make changes to the original version of (something).*

Synonyms of "Rework" as a verb (11 Words)

<u>ameliorate</u>	Get better. <i>The reform did much to ameliorate living standards.</i>
better	Get better. <i>His account can hardly be bettered.</i>
correct	Make right or correct. <i>Engineers will work to correct the effects of air resistance.</i>
improve	To make better. <i>The weather improved toward evening.</i>
make better	Consider as being.
make over	Charge with a function; charge to be.
mend	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. <i>Quarrels could be mended by talking.</i>

- rectify** Set straight or right.
*His methods of **rectifying** the cycloid.*
- refine** Improve or perfect by pruning or polishing.
*Many valuable nutrients are **refined** out of the foods in our modern diet.*
- rehabilitate** Return (something, especially a building or environmental feature) to its former condition.
*Helping to **rehabilitate** former criminals.*
- retread** Go back over (a path or one's steps).
*1 3 million tyres were **retreaded**.*

Usage Examples of "Rework" as a verb

- *He reworked the orchestral score for two pianos.*
- *Over the course of our trip, the President continually reworked his speech.*
