## The Forms of Rick

Infinitive	<b>to rick</b>
Present Tense	<b>rick / ricks</b>
Past Tense	<b>ricked</b>
Present Participle	<b>ricking</b>
Past Participle	<b>ricked</b>

## Conjugate Rick

### Rick in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>rick</b>	We <b>rick</b>
You <b>rick</b>	You <b>rick</b>
He/She/It <b>ricks</b>	They <b>rick</b>

### **Rick in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am ricking</b>	We <b>are ricking</b>
You <b>are ricking</b>	You <b>are ricking</b>
He/She/It <b>is ricking</b>	They <b>are ricking</b>

### **Rick in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have ricked</b>	We <b>have ricked</b>
You <b>have ricked</b>	You <b>have ricked</b>
He/She/It <b>has ricked</b>	They <b>have ricked</b>

### **Rick in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been ricking</b>	We <b>have been ricking</b>
You <b>have been ricking</b>	You <b>have been ricking</b>
He/She/It <b>has been ricking</b>	They <b>have been ricking</b>

### **Rick in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>ricked</b>	We <b>ricked</b>
You <b>ricked</b>	You <b>ricked</b>
He/She/It <b>ricked</b>	They <b>ricked</b>

### **Rick in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was ricking</b>	We <b>were ricking</b>
You <b>were ricking</b>	You <b>were ricking</b>
He/She/It <b>was ricking</b>	They <b>were ricking</b>

**Rick in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had ricked</b>	We <b>had ricked</b>
You <b>had ricked</b>	You <b>had ricked</b>
He/She/It <b>had ricked</b>	They <b>had ricked</b>

**Rick in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had been ricking</b>	We <b>had been ricking</b>
You <b>had been ricking</b>	You <b>had been ricking</b>
He/She/It <b>had been ricking</b>	They <b>had been ricking</b>

**Rick in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will rick</b>	We <b>will rick</b>
You <b>will rick</b>	You <b>will rick</b>
He/She/It <b>will rick</b>	They <b>will rick</b>

**Rick in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>will be ricking</b>	We <b>will be ricking</b>
You <b>will be ricking</b>	You <b>will be ricking</b>
He/She/It <b>will be ricking</b>	They <b>will be ricking</b>

**Rick in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have ricked**

**We will have ricked**

**You will have ricked**

**You will have ricked**

**He/She/It will have ricked**

**They will have ricked**

**Rick in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been ricking**

**We will have been ricking**

**You will have been ricking**

**You will have been ricking**

**He/She/It will have been ricking**

**They will have been ricking**
