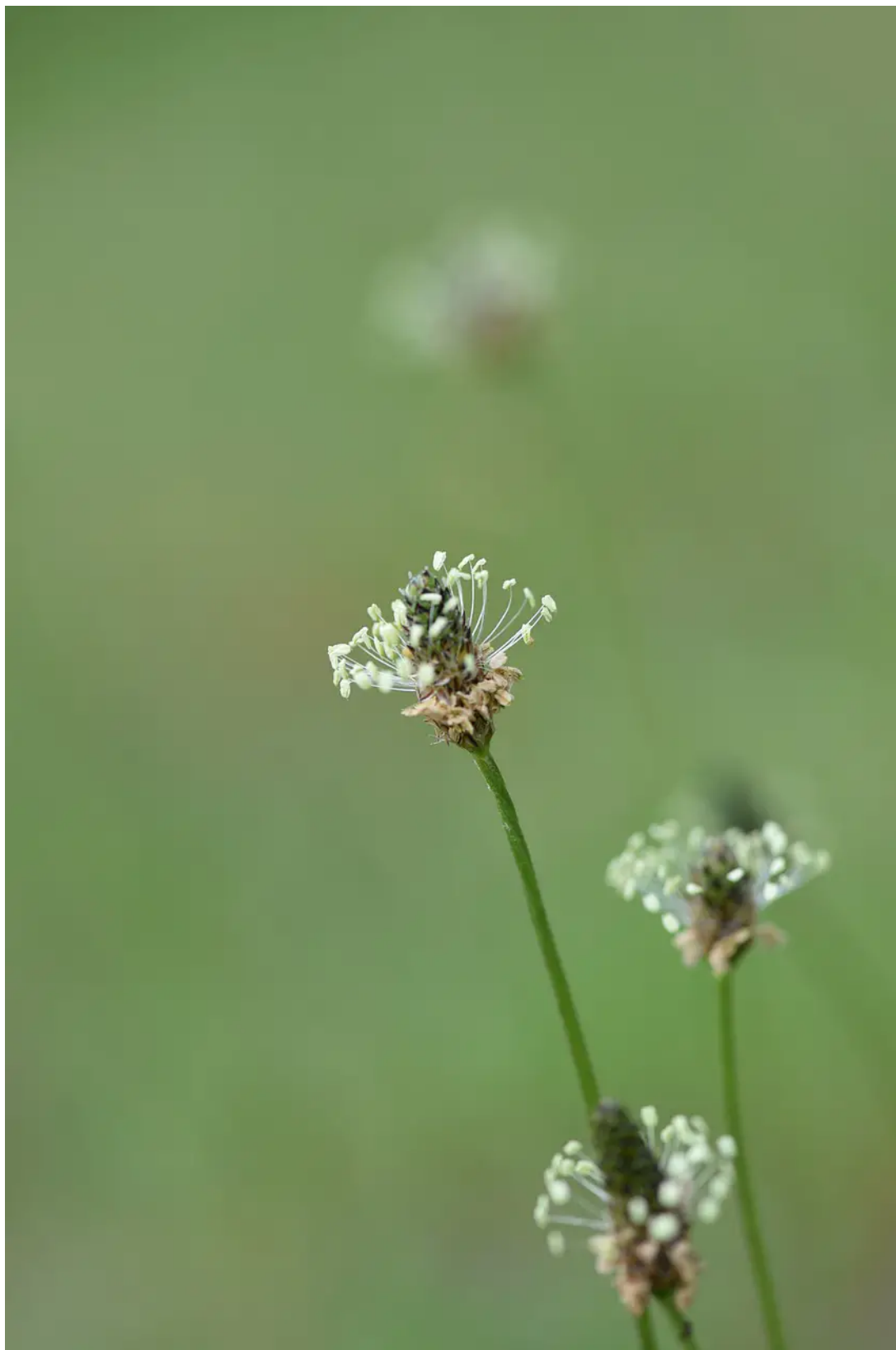

### Definitions of "Rid" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “rid” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make someone or something free of (an unwanted person or thing).*
- *Relieve from.*



## Synonyms of "Rid" as a verb (13 Words)

<b>cleanse</b>	(in biblical translations) cure (a leper). <i>Only God Himself can <b>cleanse</b> us.</i>
<b><u>clear</u></b>	Clear from impurities blemishes pollution etc. <i>The water had to be <b>cleared</b> through filtering.</i>
<b>deliver</b>	Deliver a speech oration or idea. <i>He will <b>deliver</b> a lecture on endangered species.</i> Free from embarrassment.
<b>disembarrass</b>	<i>Shouldn't empires <b>disembarrass</b> themselves of elements which no longer serve a purpose.</i>
<b><u>empty</u></b>	Become empty or void of its content. <i>The pub suddenly seemed to <b>empty</b>.</i>
<b>free</b>	Free from obligations or duties. <i><b>Free</b> your body of excess tension.</i>
<b>make free</b>	Head into a specified direction.
<b>purge</b>	Empty one's stomach or bowels by inducing vomiting or using laxatives. <i>Buildings may be <b>purged</b> of the showy symbolism of the late twentieth century.</i>
<b><u>purify</u></b>	Make pure or free from sin or guilt. <i>A ritual bath to <b>purify</b> the soul.</i>
<b>relieve</b>	Relieve oneself of troubling information. <i>He <b>relieved</b> her of her baggage.</i>
<b><u>scour</u></b>	Remove dirt or unwanted matter by scouring. <i>Use an electric toothbrush to <b>scour</b> off plaque.</i>
<b><u>void</u></b>	Declare invalid. <i>The gases are usually <b>voided</b> into the mechanism.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Rid" as a verb

- *We now have the greatest chance ever to rid the world of nuclear weapons.*
- *Ken tried to rid himself of his guests.*
- *Boil the peel to rid it of bitterness.*
