## Synonyms of "Rid" as a verb (13 Words)

cleanse (in biblical translations) cure (a leper).

Only God Himself can cleanse us.

Clear from impurities blemishes pollution etc.

The water had to be **clear**ed through filtering.

**deliver** Deliver a speech oration or idea.

He will **deliver** a lecture on endangered species.

Free from embarrassment.

**disembarrass** Shouldn t empires **disembarrass** themselves of elements which no longer

serve a purpose.

Become empty or void of its content.

The pub suddenly seemed to **empty**.

**free** Free from obligations or duties. **Free** your body of excess tension.

**make free** Head into a specified direction.

Empty one's stomach or bowels by inducing vomiting or using laxatives.

**purge** Buildings may be **purge**d of the showy symbolism of the late twentieth

century.

Make pure or free from sin or guilt.

A ritual bath to **purify** the soul.

**relieve** Relieve oneself of troubling information.

He **relieve**d her of her baggage.

Remove dirt or unwanted matter by scouring.

*Use an electric toothbrush to* **scour** *off plaque.* 

void Declare invalid.

The gases are usually **void**ed into the mechanism.
