Definitions of "Rid" as a verb

- *Make someone or something free of (an unwanted person or thing).*
- *Relieve from.*



Synonyms of "Rid" as a verb (13 Words)

cleanse	(in biblical translations) cure (a leper). <i>Only God Himself can cleanse us.</i>
clear	Clear from impurities blemishes pollution etc. <i>The water had to be cleared through filtering.</i>
deliver	Deliver a speech oration or idea. <i>He will deliver a lecture on endangered species.</i> Free from embarrassment.
disembarrass	<i>Shouldn't empires disembarrass themselves of elements which no longer serve a purpose.</i>
empty	Become empty or void of its content. <i>The pub suddenly seemed to empty.</i>
free	Free from obligations or duties. <i>Free your body of excess tension.</i>
make free	Head into a specified direction.
purge	Empty one's stomach or bowels by inducing vomiting or using laxatives. <i>Buildings may be purged of the showy symbolism of the late twentieth century.</i>
purify	Make pure or free from sin or guilt. <i>A ritual bath to purify the soul.</i>
relieve	Relieve oneself of troubling information. <i>He relieved her of her baggage.</i>
scour	Remove dirt or unwanted matter by scouring. <i>Use an electric toothbrush to scour off plaque.</i>
void	Declare invalid. <i>The gases are usually voided into the mechanism.</i>



Usage Examples of "Rid" as a verb

- *We now have the greatest chance ever to rid the world of nuclear weapons.*
- *Ken tried to rid himself of his guests.*
- *Boil the peel to rid it of bitterness.*
