## Associations of "Riddled" (30 Words)

<b>abstruse</b>	Difficult to understand; obscure. <i>An <b>abstruse</b> philosophical inquiry.</i>
<b>abysmal</b>	Resembling an abyss in depth; so deep as to be unmeasurable. <i><b>Abysmal</b> misery.</i>
<a href="#">conundrum</a>	A difficult problem. <i>One of the most difficult <b>conundrums</b> for the experts.</i>
<a href="#">cryptic</a>	Of an obscure nature. <i>A <b>cryptic</b> note.</i>
<b>cryptogram</b>	A symbol or figure with secret or occult significance.
<a href="#">enigma</a>	A person or thing that is mysterious or difficult to understand. <i>Madeleine was still an <b>enigma</b> to him.</i>
<b>enigmatic</b>	Difficult to interpret or understand; mysterious. <i>So <b>enigmatic</b> that priests might have to clarify it.</i>
<a href="#">equation</a>	A statement that the values of two mathematical expressions are equal (indicated by the sign =). <i>Money also came into the <b>equation</b>.</i>
<b>esoterica</b>	Esoteric or highly specialized subjects or publications. <i>A professor of such <b>esoterica</b> as angelology and comparative shamanism.</i>
<b>factorize</b>	Resolve (a polynomial) into factors. <i>F <b>factorizes</b> completely into linear factors.</i>
<b>incomprehensible</b>	Difficult to understand. <i>A language which is <b>incomprehensible</b> to anyone outside the office.</i>
<a href="#">insurmountable</a>	Not capable of being surmounted or overcome. <i>An <b>insurmountable</b> problem.</i>

<b><u>miracle</u></b>	An exceptional product or achievement, or an outstanding example of something. <i>A machine which was a <b>miracle</b> of design.</i>
<b><u>mystery</u></b>	The practices, skills, or lore peculiar to a particular trade or activity and regarded as baffling to those without specialized knowledge. <i>How it got out is a <b>mystery</b>.</i>
<b>preternatural</b>	Surpassing the ordinary or normal. <i>Beyond his <b>preternatural</b> affability there is some acid and some steel.</i>
<b><u>puzzle</u></b>	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>Realization dawned as the pieces of the <b>puzzle</b> fell into place.</i>
<b>recondite</b>	(of a subject or knowledge) little known; abstruse. <i>Some <b>recondite</b> problem in historiography.</i>
<b>resolve</b>	Analyse (a force or velocity) into components acting in particular directions. <i>She <b>resolved</b> to ring Dana as soon as she got home.</i>
<b>secret</b>	Given in confidence or in secret. <i>How did you guess I'd got a <b>secret</b> plan.</i>
<b>solution</b>	The action of separating or breaking down dissolution. <i>An internet marketing firm specializing in e-commerce <b>solutions</b>.</i>
<b>solve</b>	Settle, as of a debt. <i><b>Solve</b> for <math>x</math>.</i>
<b>superhuman</b>	Above or beyond the human or demanding more than human power or endurance. <i><b>Superhuman</b> strength.</i>
<b>tantalize</b>	Torment or tease (someone) with the sight or promise of something that is unobtainable. <i>She still <b>tantalized</b> him.</i>
<b><u>trivia</u></b>	Something of small importance. <i>We fill our days with meaningless <b>trivia</b>.</i>
<b><u>unfathomable</u></b>	Incapable of being fully understood. <i>Her grey eyes were dark with some <b>unfathomable</b> emotion.</i>
<b>unresolved</b>	Characterized by musical dissonance harmonically unresolved. <i>A number of issues remain <b>unresolved</b>.</i>
<b>unscramble</b>	Become or cause to become undone by separating the fibers or threads of. <i>But how do we <b>unscramble</b> our feelings.</i>
<b><u>unsolved</u></b>	Not solved. <i>An <b>unsolved</b> mystery.</i>

Become or cause to become undone by separating the fibers or threads of.

**whodunit**

A story about a crime (usually murder) presented as a novel or play or movie.
