Synonyms of "Ridged" as an adjective (17 Words)

carinate Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship.

A carinate sepal.

crinkled

carinated Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship.

(of a material or surface) shaped into a series of parallel ridges and grooves so

corrugated as to give added rigidity and strength.

Corrugated cardboard.

creased Marked by creases or wrinkles. *His lined and creased face.*

Uneven by virtue of having wrinkles or waves.

A skirt in **crinkled** fabric.

crumpled (of a person) collapsed on the ground. I fell to the floor in a **crumpled** heap.

fluted Having flutes or grooves; ridged.

A pretty floral dress with fluted sleeves.



furrowed (of land or earth) covered in long, narrow trenches formed by ploughing.

He stroked his furrowed brow.

gathered Brought together in one place.

The **gathered** folds of the skirt.

Having a groove or grooves.

grooved Grooved tyres.

keeled Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship.

A deep **keeled** yacht.

rippled Shaken into waves or undulations as by wind.

The **rippled** surface of the pond.

rumpled In disarray; extremely disorderly.

A **rumpled** bed.

Divided or edged with a line formed of alternating shallow curves.

She had long **wavy** hair.

wrinkled Marked by wrinkles.

You just cannot look neat with **wrinkled** clothes.

wrinkly Having many lines or folds.

Her thin **wrinkly** face.
