- carinate** Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship.

- carinated** Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship.
(of a material or surface) shaped into a series of parallel ridges and grooves so
- corrugated** as to give added rigidity and strength.
***Corrugated** cardboard.*
- creased** Marked by creases or wrinkles.
*His lined and **creased** face.*
- crinkled** Uneven by virtue of having wrinkles or waves.
*A skirt in **crinkled** fabric.*
- crumpled** (of a person) collapsed on the ground.
*I fell to the floor in a **crumpled** heap.*
- fluted** Having flutes or grooves; ridged.
*A pretty floral dress with **fluted** sleeves.*

furrowed	(of land or earth) covered in long, narrow trenches formed by ploughing. <i>He stroked his furrowed brow.</i>
gathered	Brought together in one place. <i>The gathered folds of the skirt.</i>
grooved	Having a groove or grooves. <i>Grooved tyres.</i>
keeled	Having a ridge or shaped like a ridge or suggesting the keel of a ship. <i>A deep keeled yacht.</i>
rippled	Shaken into waves or undulations as by wind. <i>The rippled surface of the pond.</i>
rumpled	In disarray; extremely disorderly. <i>A rumpled bed.</i>
<u>wavy</u>	Divided or edged with a line formed of alternating shallow curves. <i>She had long wavy hair.</i>
wrinkled	Marked by wrinkles. <i>You just cannot look neat with wrinkled clothes.</i>
wrinkly	Having many lines or folds. <i>Her thin wrinkly face.</i>
