- A monologue or spoken improvisation, especially a humorous one, on a particular subject.






Synonyms of "Riff" as a noun (1 Word)

- A brilliant guitar riff.






Riff as a Verb

Definitions of "Riff" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "riff" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Perform a monologue or spoken improvisation on a particular subject.
- Look through a book or other written material.
- Play riffs.





Synonyms of "Riff" as a verb (5 Words)

Remove with a flick of the hand. flick

He **flick**ed his Bic.

Go mad, go crazy.

<u>flip</u> My mum will **flip** if I don t get my homework done tonight.

(of a plant, especially a deciduous one in spring) put out new leaves. leaf

Leaf through a book.

Search quickly through (something. riffle

She opened a book and riffled the pages.

thumb

Turn over pages with or as if with one s thumb. He was **thumb**ing through USA Today for the umpteenth time.
