appointed	Subject to appointment. <i>A luxuriously appointed lounge.</i>
arranged	Deliberately arranged for effect. <i>The carefully arranged chessmen.</i>
array	An impressive display or range of a particular type of thing. <i>A bewildering array of choices.</i>
automate	Convert (a process or facility) to be operated by largely automatic equipment. <i>Automate the movement of the robot.</i>
codify	Organize into a code or system, such as a body of law. <i>This would codify existing intergovernmental cooperation on drugs.</i>
configure	Arrange or order (a computer system or an element of it) so as to fit it for a designated task. <i>The memory can be configured as a virtual drive.</i>
deactivation	Breaking up a military unit (by transfers or discharges).
defraud	Illegally obtain money from (someone) by deception. <i>She defrauded the customers who trusted her.</i>
disorganized	Not properly planned and controlled. <i>She s very muddled and disorganized.</i>
echelon	Arrange in an echelon formation. <i>The rear echelon.</i>
equip	Supply with the necessary items for a particular purpose. <i>She was never equipped to be a dancer.</i>
furnish	Be a source of; provide. <i>Fish furnish an important source of protein.</i>
intercom	An electrical device allowing one-way or two-way communication. <i>The pilot s voice comes over the intercom.</i>

logistics	Handling an operation that involves providing labor and materials be supplied as needed. <i>The logistics of a large scale rock show demand certain necessities.</i>
ordered	Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>An ordered sequence.</i>
ordering	Logical or comprehensible arrangement of separate elements. <i>There were mistakes in the ordering of items on the list.</i>
<u>perpetrate</u>	Perform an act, usually with a negative connotation. <i>A crime has been perpetrated against a sovereign state.</i>
preparation	A note that produces a dissonant chord is first heard in a consonant chord. <i>A microscope preparation.</i>
<u>prepare</u>	Prepare for eating by applying heat. <i>Prepare a brief summary of the article.</i>
prepared	Equipped or prepared with necessary intellectual resources. <i>He paints over the prepared canvas with brown acrylic to bring out the cracks.</i>
<u>procurement</u>	The action of obtaining or procuring something. <i>The company s procurements from foreign firms.</i>
provide	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. <i>Provide for the proper care of the passengers on the cruise ship.</i>
purposely	With intention; in an intentional manner. <i>She had purposely made it difficult.</i>
scam	A dishonest scheme; a fraud. <i>An insurance scam.</i>
scheme	Devise a system or form a scheme for. <i>He schemed to bring about the collapse of the government.</i>
setup	Equipment designed to serve a specific function. <i>It takes time to learn the setup around here.</i>
standby	Something that can be relied on when needed. <i>Passengers were obliged to go on standby.</i>
swindle	Obtain (money) fraudulently. <i>A businessman swindled investors out of millions of pounds.</i>
trick	A cunning or deceitful action or device. <i>I thought I saw a flicker of emotion but it was probably a trick of the light.</i>
victimize	Make a victim of. <i>They are victimized by racism or discriminatory barriers.</i>
