acknowledgement	A statement printed at the beginning of a book expressing the author's or publisher's gratitude to others. <i>There was no acknowledgement of the family's trauma.</i>
affordable	That you have the financial means for. <i>Affordable homes.</i>
applicable	Relevant or appropriate. <i>Gave applicable examples to support her argument.</i>
apposite	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>The observations are apposite to the discussion.</i>
appropriate	Take (something) for one's own use, typically without the owner's permission. <i>A measure appropriate to a wartime economy.</i>
apropos	At an opportune time. <i>The composer's reference to child's play is apropos.</i>
apt	Naturally disposed toward. <i>An apt pupil.</i>
beeline	The most direct route. <i>He made a beeline for the bathroom.</i>
befitting	Appropriate to. <i>Behavior befitting a father.</i>
correct	Make right or correct. <i>The Council issued a statement correcting some points in the press reports.</i>
corrective	A device for treating injury or disease. <i>Management were informed so that corrective action could be taken.</i>
correctly	In a way that is true, factual or appropriate; accurately. <i>She had acted correctly.</i>

<u>far</u>	Located at a great distance in time or space or degree. <i>He was standing in the far corner.</i>
fitting	Being precisely fitting and right. <i>Little remains of the house s Victorian fittings.</i>
germane	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>That is not germane to our theme.</i>
inaccessible	Unable to be reached. <i>Such costs would make litigation inaccessible to private individuals.</i>
<u>just</u>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>A just reward.</i>
<u>justification</u>	The action of showing something to be right or reasonable. <i>There is no justification for an increase in charges.</i>
legitimate	Show or affirm to be just and legitimate. <i>A legitimate excuse for being late.</i>
<u>opportune</u>	Done or occurring at a favourable time; well timed. <i>An opportune time to receive guests.</i>
pertinence	Relevance by virtue of being applicable to the matter at hand.
pertinent	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>Practitioners must consider all factors pertinent to a situation.</i>
proper	Belonging to oneself or itself; own. <i>Her parents view of what was proper for a well bred girl.</i>
<u>properly</u>	Appropriately for the circumstances; suitably or respectably. <i>If you don t behave properly you ll have to leave.</i>
<u>propriety</u>	The details or rules of behaviour conventionally considered to be correct. <i>They questioned the propriety of certain investments made by the council.</i>
<u>relevance</u>	The relation of something to the matter at hand. <i>The quantity quality and relevance of links count towards your rating.</i>
<u>relevant</u>	Having a bearing on or connection with the subject at issue. <i>The candidate s experience is relevant to the job.</i>
<u>remote</u>	A remote control device. <i>Chances of a lasting peace became even more remote.</i>
rightness	According with conscience or morality. <i>They argue for the moral rightness of overthrowing the leader by force.</i>
