<u>apt</u>	Naturally disposed toward. An apt pupil.
beeline	The most direct route. He made a beeline for the bathroom.
befitting	Appropriate to. Behavior befitting a father.
correct	Make right or correct. The Council issued a statement correct ing some points in the press reports.
<u>corrective</u>	A device for treating injury or disease. Management were informed so that corrective action could be taken
<u>correctly</u>	In a way that is true, factual or appropriate; accurately. She had acted correctly .



<u>far</u>	Located at a great distance in time or space or degree. <i>He was standing in the far corner.</i>
fitting	Being precisely fitting and right. <i>Little remains of the house s Victorian fittings.</i>
germane	Relevant to a subject under consideration. That is not germane to our theme.
inaccessible	Unable to be reached. Such costs would make litigation inaccessible to private individuals.
<u>just</u>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. A just reward.
justification	The action of showing something to be right or reasonable. There is no justification for an increase in charges.
legitimate	Show or affirm to be just and legitimate. A legitimate excuse for being late.
<u>opportune</u>	Done or occurring at a favourable time; well timed. An opportune time to receive guests.
pertinence	Relevance by virtue of being applicable to the matter at hand.
pertinent	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. Practitioners must consider all factors pertinent to a situation.
proper	Belonging to oneself or itself; own. Her parents view of what was proper for a well bred girl.
properly	Appropriately for the circumstances; suitably or respectably. If you don t behave properly you ll have to leave.
<u>propriety</u>	The details or rules of behaviour conventionally considered to be correct. They questioned the propriety of certain investments made by the council.
<u>relevance</u>	The relation of something to the matter at hand. The quantity quality and relevance of links count towards your rating.
<u>relevant</u>	Having a bearing on or connection with the subject at issue. The candidate s experience is relevant to the job.
remote	A remote control device. Chances of a lasting peace became even more remote .
rightness	According with conscience or morality. They argue for the moral rightness of overthrowing the leader by force.
