## Associations of "Right off the bat" (30 Words)

<b>abrogation</b>	The repeal or abolition of a law, right, or agreement.
<b>acknowledgement</b>	Recognition of the importance or quality of something. <i>He received an award in <b>acknowledgement</b> of his work.</i>
<b>applicable</b>	Capable of being applied; having relevance. <i>Gave <b>applicable</b> examples to support her argument.</i>
<a href="#">apposite</a>	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>The successful copywriter is a master of <b>apposite</b> and evocative verbal images.</i>
<b>appropriate</b>	Take (something) for one’s own use, typically without the owner’s permission. <i>It seems that an apology is <b>appropriate</b>.</i>
<a href="#">apropos</a>	At an opportune time. <i>The song feels <b>apropos</b> to a midnight jaunt.</i>
<a href="#">apt</a>	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>An <b>apt</b> pupil.</i>
<a href="#">barely</a>	By a little. <i>The network has <b>barely</b> 5 percent of viewers.</i>
<b>befitting</b>	Appropriate to. <i>Behavior <b>befitting</b> a father.</i>
<b>coincidentally</b>	At the same time. <i>The three are <b>coincidentally</b> reunited when captured by the enemy.</i>
<b>correct</b>	Socially right or correct. <i>The Council issued a statement <b>correcting</b> some points in the press reports.</i>
<a href="#">corrective</a>	Tending or intended to correct or counteract or restore to a normal condition. <i><b>Corrective</b> lenses.</i>

<b>desirability</b>	Attractiveness to the opposite sex. <i>We agree on the <b>desirability</b> of a negotiated settlement.</i>
<b>felicitous</b>	Marked by good fortune. <i>A <b>felicitous</b> life.</i>
<b>fitting</b>	Being precisely fitting and right. <i>Little remains of the house's Victorian <b> fittings</b>.</i>
<b>germane</b>	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>That is not <b>germane</b> to our theme.</i>
<b>handed</b>	Having or involving the use of hands. <i>A four <b>handed</b> card game.</i>
<b>just</b>	Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i><b>Just</b> a scratch.</i>
<b>justification</b>	The act of defending or explaining or making excuses for by reasoning. <i>The <b>justification</b> of revolutionary action.</i>
<b>justness</b>	Conformity with some esthetic standard of correctness or propriety. <i>It was performed with <b>justness</b> and beauty.</i>
<b>mistaken</b>	Wrong in one's opinion or judgement. <i>A <b>mistaken</b> belief.</i>
<b>opportune</b>	(of a time) especially convenient or appropriate for a particular action or event. <i>The <b>opportune</b> use of humour to lower tension.</i>
<b>pertinence</b>	Relevance by virtue of being applicable to the matter at hand.
<b>pertinent</b>	Being of striking appropriateness and pertinence. <i>A list of articles <b>pertinent</b> to the discussion.</i>
<b>proper</b>	The part of a church service that varies with the season or feast. <i><b>Proper</b> medical treatment.</i>
<b>relevant</b>	Closely connected or appropriate to what is being done or considered. <i>The candidate's experience is <b>relevant</b> to the job.</i>
<b>righteous</b>	Correctly so called; genuine. <i>Victory in battle was conferred on the <b>righteous</b>.</i>
<b>rightness</b>	The quality or state of being true or correct as a fact. <i>The <b>rightness</b> of that move for me.</i>
<b>scarcely</b>	Only a very short time before. <i>Her voice is so low I can <b>scarcely</b> hear what she is saying.</i>
<b>timely</b>	At an opportune time. <i>A <b>timely</b> warning.</i>
