Present Tense	ring-bark / ring-barks
Past Tense	ring-barked
Present Participle	ring-barking

Conjugate Ring-bark

Ring-bark in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **ring-bark** We **ring-bark**
You **ring-bark** You **ring-bark**
He/She/It **ring-barks** They **ring-bark**

Ring-bark in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am ring-barking** We **are ring-barking**
You **are ring-barking** You **are ring-barking**
He/She/It **is ring-barking** They **are ring-barking**

Ring-bark in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have ring-barked** We **have ring-barked**
You **have ring-barked** You **have ring-barked**
He/She/It **has ring-barked** They **have ring-barked**

Ring-bark in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I **have been ring-barking** We **have been ring-barking**
You **have been ring-barking** You **have been ring-barking**
He/She/It **has been ring-barking** They **have been ring-barking**

Ring-bark in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was ring-barking We were ring-barking
You were ring-barking You were ring-barking
He/She/It was ring-barking They were ring-barking

I had ring-barked We had ring-barked
You had ring-barked You had ring-barked
He/She/It had ring-barked They had ring-barked

Ring-bark in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been ring-barking We had been ring-barking
You had been ring-barking You had been ring-barking
He/She/It had been ring-barking They had been ring-barking

Ring-bark in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will ring-bark We will ring-bark
You will ring-bark You will ring-bark
He/She/It will ring-bark They will ring-bark

Ring-bark in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be ring-barking We will be ring-barking
You will be ring-barking You will be ring-barking
He/She/It will be ring-barking They will be ring-barking

We will have ring-barked

You will have ring-barked

You will have ring-barked

He/She/It will have ring-barked

They will have ring-barked
