# **Conjugate Ring**

## **Ring in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>ring</b>	We <b>ring</b>
You <b>ring</b>	You <b>ring</b>
He/She/It <b>rings</b>	They <b>ring</b>

## **Ring in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am ringing	We <b>are ringing</b>
You <b>are ringing</b>	You <b>are ringing</b>
He/She/It is ringing	They <b>are ringing</b>

## **Ring in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have ringed	We have ringed
You have ringed	You have ringed
He/She/It has ringed	They have ringed

# **Ring in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been ringing	We have been ringing
You <b>have been ringing</b>	You <b>have been ringing</b>
He/She/It has been ringing	They have been ringing

# **Ring in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>ringed</b>	We <b>ringed</b>
You <b>ringed</b>	You <b>ringed</b>
He/She/It <b>ringed</b>	They <b>ringed</b>

#### **Ring in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was ringing	We were ringing
You <b>were ringing</b>	You <b>were ringing</b>
He/She/It was ringing	They were ringing

## **Ring in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had ringed	We <b>had ringed</b>
You <b>had ringed</b>	You <b>had ringed</b>
He/She/It had ringed	They had ringed

## **Ring in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been ringing	We had been ringing
You <b>had been ringing</b>	You had been ringing
He/She/It had been ringing	They had been ringing

# **Ring in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will ring</b>	We will ring
You <b>will ring</b>	You <b>will ring</b>
He/She/It will ring	They will ring

# **Ring in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be ringing	We <b>will be ringing</b>
You <b>will be ringing</b>	You <b>will be ringing</b>
He/She/It will be ringing	They will be ringing

## **Ring in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been ringing	We <b>will have been ringing</b>
You <b>will have been ringing</b>	You <b>will have been ringing</b>
He/She/It will have been ringing	They will have been ringing
