## Associations of "Risk taker" (30 Words)

<b>avalanche</b>	Engulf or carry off by an avalanche. <i>We have had an <b>avalanche</b> of applications for the post.</i>
<b>averse</b>	(usually followed by `to') strongly opposed. <i>As a former CIA director he is not <b>averse</b> to secrecy.</i>
<b>challenge</b>	Issue a challenge to. <i>Human <b>challenge</b> studies occur in tightly controlled settings.</i>
<b>danger</b>	A dangerous place. <i>He moved out of <b>danger</b>.</i>
<b>dangerous</b>	Causing fear or anxiety by threatening great harm. <i>Insecticides which are <b>dangerous</b> to the environment.</i>
<b>dare</b>	To be courageous enough to try or do something. <i>She ran across a main road for a <b>dare</b>.</i>
<b>dicey</b>	Unpredictable and potentially dangerous. <i>An extremely <b>dicey</b> future on a brave new world of liquid nitrogen tar and smog.</i>
<b>flammability</b>	The quality of being easily ignited and burning rapidly.
<b>foreseeable</b>	Able to be foreseen or predicted. <i>The situation is unlikely to change in the <b>foreseeable</b> future.</i>
<a href="#">gamble</a>	A risky act or venture. <i>Dad likes a bit of a <b>gamble</b>.</i>
<a href="#">hazard</a>	An unknown and unpredictable phenomenon that causes an event to result one way rather than another. <i>Drinking alcohol is a health <b>hazard</b>.</i>
<a href="#">hazardous</a>	Involving risk or danger. <i>It is <b>hazardous</b> to personal safety.</i>
<b>imminence</b>	The state or fact of being about to happen. <i>The populace was largely unaware of the <b>imminence</b> of war.</i>

<b><u>insecure</u></b>	Not firm or fixed; liable to give way or break. <i>Badly paid and <b>insecure</b> jobs.</i>
<b>jeopardy</b>	Danger of loss, harm, or failure. <i>The whole peace process is in <b>jeopardy</b>.</i>
<b>landslide</b>	An overwhelming majority of votes for one party or candidate in an election. <i>Businessmen have been buried under a <b>landslide</b> of paperwork.</i>
<b>neurotoxin</b>	A poison which acts on the nervous system.
<b>parlous</b>	Full of danger or uncertainty; precarious. <i>The General's position was <b>parlous</b>.</i>
<b>peril</b>	Serious and immediate danger. <i>Jonathon <b>perilled</b> his life for love of David.</i>
<b><u>perilous</u></b>	Full of danger or risk. <i>A <b>perilous</b> journey south.</i>
<b>perilously</b>	In a dangerous manner. <i>Houses perched <b>perilously</b> on craggy outposts.</i>
<b><u>pitfall</u></b>	A trap in the form of a concealed hole. <i>The <b>pitfalls</b> of buying goods at public auctions.</i>
<b><u>precarious</u></b>	Fraught with danger. <i>He made a <b>precarious</b> living as a painter.</i>
<b><u>risky</u></b>	Not financially safe or secure. <i>Anything that promises to pay too much can't help being <b>risky</b>.</i>
<b><u>shaky</u></b>	Unstable because of poor construction or heavy use. <i>A <b>shaky</b> marriage.</i>
<b>threatened</b>	Likely in the near future to become endangered. <i>The spotted owl is a <b>threatened</b> species not yet an endangered one.</i>
<b><u>toxicity</u></b>	Grave harmfulness or deadliness. <i>That was how I protected my partner from my family's <b>toxicity</b>.</i>
<b>unsafe</b>	Not safe; dangerous. <i>Drinking water in some areas may be <b>unsafe</b>.</i>
<b>venture</b>	Any venturesome undertaking especially one with an uncertain outcome. <i>May I <b>venture</b> to add a few comments.</i>
<b>volatility</b>	Tendency of a substance to evaporate at normal temperatures. <i>The <b>volatility</b> of the market drove many investors away.</i>
