## Roadblock as a Noun

### Definitions of "Roadblock" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “roadblock” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A barrier or barricade on a road, especially one set up by the authorities to stop and examine traffic.*
- *A barrier set up by police to stop traffic on a street or road in order to catch a fugitive or inspect traffic etc.*
- *A hindrance or obstruction.*
- *Any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective.*



## Synonyms of "Roadblock" as a noun (5 Words)

- barricade** An improvised barrier erected across a street or other thoroughfare to prevent or delay the movement of opposing forces.  
*They stormed the **barricade**.*
- barrier** Anything serving to maintain separation by obstructing vision or access.  
*The mountain **barrier** between Norway and Sweden.*
- blockade** An act or means of sealing off a place to prevent goods or people from entering or leaving.  
*They voted to lift the **blockade** of major railway junctions.*
- [checkpoint](#) A place (as at a frontier) where travellers are stopped for inspection and clearance.
- [obstruction](#) The physical condition of blocking or filling a passage with an obstruction.  
*He was charged with **obstruction** of a police officer in the execution of his duty.*



## Usage Examples of "Roadblock" as a noun

- *Police roadblocks.*
- *The biggest roadblock to solar power is its price tag.*
- *The tax has become a roadblock against investment incentives.*
