Definitions of "Roadblock" as a noun

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "roadblock" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A barrier or barricade on a road, especially one set up by the authorities to stop and examine traffic.
- A barrier set up by police to stop traffic on a street or road in order to catch a fugitive or inspect traffic etc.
- A hindrance or obstruction.
- Any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective.

An improvised barrier erected across a street or other thoroughfare to

barricade prevent or delay the movement of opposing forces.

They stormed the **barricade**.

Anything serving to maintain separation by obstructing vision or access. barrier

The mountain **barrier** between Norway and Sweden.

An act or means of sealing off a place to prevent goods or people from

blockade entering or leaving.

They voted to lift the **blockade** of major railway junctions.

A place (as at a frontier) where travellers are stopped for inspection and **checkpoint** clearance.

The physical condition of blocking or filling a passage with an obstruction.

obstruction He was charged with **obstruction** of a police officer in the execution of his

duty.
