capacity	(computer science) the amount of information (in bytes) that can be stored on a disk drive. <i>Cases where a patient's testamentary capacity is in doubt.</i>
chamber	A private room, especially a bedroom. <i>The upper chamber is the senate.</i>
elbow room	A length of pipe with a sharp bend in it.
free space	People who are free.
freedom	The condition of being free; the power to act or speak or think without externally imposed restraints. <i>He accepted the freedom of the City of Glasgow.</i>
latitude	The angular distance of a place north or south of the earth's equator, or of the equator of a celestial object, usually expressed in degrees and minutes. <i>Temperate latitudes.</i>
leeway	A permissible difference; allowing some freedom to move within limits. <i>The government had greater leeway to introduce reforms.</i>

quarters	A quarter of a hundredweight (25 pounds). <i>He found quarters for his family.</i>
scope	A telescope microscope or other device having a name ending in scope. <i>Infrared night scopes.</i>
space	The unlimited expanse in which everything is located. <i>It is the media person s job to buy the press space or the TV or radio spots.</i>
way	A general category of things used in the expression in the way of. <i>I hated their way of cooking potatoes.</i>

have rooms Receive willingly something given or offered.

lodge

Be a lodger stay temporarily.

*The variety is high yielding but it has mostly **lodged**.*

accommodation	Making or becoming suitable; adjusting to circumstances. <i>Overnight accommodations are available.</i>
antechamber	A large entrance or reception room or area. <i>The antechamber to an interview room.</i>
anteroom	A large entrance or reception room or area.
<u>apartment</u>	A block of apartments. <i>A district of six storey apartments arranged along narrow streets.</i>
attic	The dialect of Ancient Greek spoken and written in Attica and Athens and Ionia. <i>I discovered a dozen rolls of the original wallpaper in a tin trunk in the attic.</i>
bathroom	A set of matching units to be fitted in a bathroom especially as sold together. <i>I have to go to the bathroom.</i>
<u>bedroom</u>	A room for sleeping in. <i>A two bedroom flat.</i>

bedside	The space beside a bed (used especially with reference to an invalid's bed). A bedside lamp.
<u>cabinet</u>	A wooden box or piece of furniture housing a radio, television set, or speaker. A cabinet meeting.
caravan	Travel in a caravan. We were part of a caravan of almost a thousand camels.
<u>chamber</u>	Place in a chamber. The upper chamber .
<u>closet</u>	A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes. His brother's decision to come out of the closet .
<u>compartment</u>	A grassy mound or other support depicted below a shield. Religion and politics should be kept in different compartments .
<u>console</u>	Comfort (someone) at a time of grief or disappointment. You can console yourself with the thought that you did your best.
dome	A sports stadium with a domed roof. The dome of the sky.
doorstep	(of a journalist) wait uninvited outside the home of (someone) in order to obtain an interview or photograph. Doorstep sandwiches.
flophouse	A dosshouse. They are living in a flophouse and discovering that the streets are not paved with gold.
foyer	An entrance hall or other open area in a building used by the public, especially a hotel or theatre. The foyer of the concert hall.
<u>furniture</u>	The mountings of a rifle. The more sophisticated Mac furniture number wheels colour pickers and so on.
habitable	Fit for habitation. The house should be habitable by Christmas.
<u>hostel</u>	Inexpensive supervised lodging (especially for youths on bicycling trips).
<u>hotel</u>	A restaurant or cafe. A five star hotel .

<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen</i> Swahili.
<u>lobby</u>	In the UK lobby correspondents collectively. <i>The organization was formed to lobby for student concerns.</i>
loft	Store in a loft. <i>The best way to prevent this heat loss is by insulating the loft.</i>
motel	A roadside hotel designed primarily for motorists, typically having the rooms arranged in low blocks with parking directly outside.
plank	Cover with planks. <i>The central plank of the bill is the curb on industrial polluters.</i>
reservation	A statement that limits or restricts some claim. <i>Some generals voiced reservations about making air strikes.</i>
<u>sofa</u>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i>Sofa</i> cushions.
<u>suite</u>	A group of minerals, rocks, or fossils occurring together and characteristic of a location or period. <i>A suite of reception rooms.</i>
