- quarters** A quarter of a hundredweight (25 pounds).
*He found **quarters** for his family.*
- scope** A telescope microscope or other device having a name ending in scope.
*Infrared night **scopes**.*
- space** The unlimited expanse in which everything is located.
*It is the media person s job to buy the press **space** or the TV or radio spots.*
- way** A general category of things used in the expression in the way of.
*I hated their **way** of cooking potatoes.*

chamber	Place in a chamber. The upper chamber .
closet	A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes. His brother s decision to come out of the closet .
compartment	A grassy mound or other support depicted below a shield. Religion and politics should be kept in different compartments .
console	Comfort (someone) at a time of grief or disappointment. You can console yourself with the thought that you did your best.
dome	A sports stadium with a domed roof. The dome of the sky.
doorstep	(of a journalist) wait uninvited outside the home of (someone) in order to obtain an interview or photograph. Doorstep sandwiches.
flophouse	A dosshouse. They are living in a flophouse and discovering that the streets are not paved with gold.
foyer	An entrance hall or other open area in a building used by the public, especially a hotel or theatre. The foyer of the concert hall.
furniture	The mountings of a rifle. The more sophisticated Mac furniture number wheels colour pickers and so on.
habitable	Fit for habitation. The house should be habitable by Christmas.
hostel	Inexpensive supervised lodging (especially for youths on bicycling trips).
hotel	A restaurant or cafe. A five star hotel .

<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen</i> Swahili.
<u>lobby</u>	In the UK lobby correspondents collectively. <i>The organization was formed to lobby for student concerns.</i>
loft	Store in a loft. <i>The best way to prevent this heat loss is by insulating the loft.</i>
motel	A roadside hotel designed primarily for motorists, typically having the rooms arranged in low blocks with parking directly outside.
plank	Cover with planks. <i>The central plank of the bill is the curb on industrial polluters.</i>
reservation	A statement that limits or restricts some claim. <i>Some generals voiced reservations about making air strikes.</i>
<u>sofa</u>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i>Sofa</i> cushions.
<u>suite</u>	A group of minerals, rocks, or fossils occurring together and characteristic of a location or period. <i>A suite of reception rooms.</i>
