Infinitive	<b>to route</b>
Present Tense	<b>route / routes</b>
Past Tense	<b>routed</b>
Present Participle	<b>routing or routeing (uk)</b>
Past Participle	<b>routed</b>

## Conjugate Route

### Route in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular          Plural**

I **route**                  We **route**  
You **route**              You **route**  
He/She/It **routes**    They **route**

**Route in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am routing or routeing (uk)**          We **are routing or routeing (uk)**  
You **are routing or routeing (uk)**      You **are routing or routeing (uk)**  
He/She/It **is routing or routeing (uk)**    They **are routing or routeing (uk)**

**Route in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have routed**                  We **have routed**  
You **have routed**              You **have routed**  
He/She/It **has routed**        They **have routed**

**Route in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been routing or routeing (uk)**          We **have been routing or routeing (uk)**  
You **have been routing or routeing (uk)**      You **have been routing or routeing (uk)**  
He/She/It **has been routing or routeing (uk)**    They **have been routing or routeing (uk)**

**Route in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **routed**                  We **routed**  
You **routed**              You **routed**  
He/She/It **routed**        They **routed**

## Route in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

### Singular

I was routing or routeing (uk)

You were routing or routeing (uk)

He/She/It was routing or routeing (uk)

### Plural

We were routing or routeing (uk)

You were routing or routeing (uk)

They were routing or routeing (uk)

## Route in Past Perfect Tense

### Singular

I had routed

You had routed

He/She/It had routed

### Plural

We had routed

You had routed

They had routed

## Route in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

### Singular

I had been routing or routeing (uk)

You had been routing or routeing (uk)

He/She/It had been routing or routeing (uk)

### Plural

We had been routing or routeing (uk)

You had been routing or routeing (uk)

They had been routing or routeing (uk)

## Route in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

### Singular

I will route

You will route

He/She/It will route

### Plural

We will route

You will route

They will route

## Route in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

### Singular

I will be routing or routeing (uk)

You will be routing or routeing (uk)

He/She/It will be routing or routeing (uk)

### Plural

We will be routing or routeing (uk)

You will be routing or routeing (uk)

They will be routing or routeing (uk)

## **Route in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have routed**

**You will have routed**

**He/She/It will have routed**

### **Plural**

**We will have routed**

**You will have routed**

**They will have routed**

## **Route in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have been routing or routeing (uk)**

**You will have been routing or routeing (uk)**

**He/She/It will have been routing or routeing (uk)**

### **Plural**

**We will have been routing or routeing (uk)**

**You will have been routing or routeing (uk)**

**They will have been routing or routeing (uk)**
